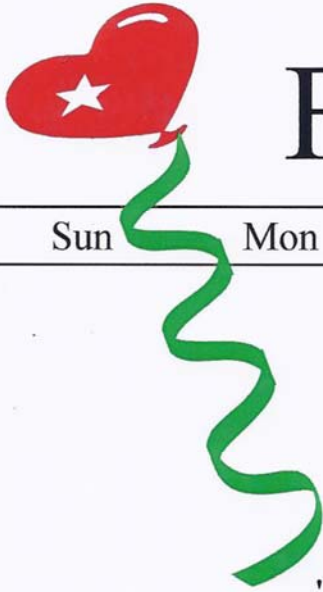

Deadline for 2014 Dues and Assessments is April 1st

Statements for the 2014 Dues and Assessments will be mailed out on February 10th. The amount for 2014 will be \$595.00 (\$25 Dues & \$570 Assessment) & \$59.50 for each additional lot. This is a \$20 increase in assessments, the first increase in several years. Payment must be received in the office before April 2nd to avoid a 10% penalty. A monthly finance charge of 1 ½ % is charged on all outstanding balances. Boat permits & golf carts are the same as last year. Boats with a motor are \$50 and all others are \$15. Golf carts are \$20 but night operation golf carts will require inspection before the new permits are issued. If you mail in your payments, permits and passes will be returned by mail except for the night operation golf cart permits.

C.E.R.T. Corner

For many, the New Year is a time for setting goals and making new resolutions for the year to come. If you are anything like me, each year you find yourself resolving to achieve a healthier lifestyle - eating right, exercising more, losing a few pounds.

Setting personal health goals in the New Year is great, but improving overall well-being involves taking actions to be prepared. Knowing what to do in an emergency is vital to the health and safety of you and your loved ones.

Start the New Year by connecting with family and friends on the importance of preparedness. Not only can the information shared potentially save a life, connecting with those you love has an added benefit. People who have strong social connections tend to be healthier and more resilient.

I know the hardest part of keeping a resolution is sustaining it after those first few weeks of the year, but you don't have to do it all at once.

First, start by simply having the conversation: who to call, where to meet and what to pack in an emergency.

Build your family's emergency supply kit by picking up recommended emergency items over the first month or two of the year.

Create a preparedness checklist. This should include things such as emergency phone numbers and copies of important documents.

Set reminders throughout the year to talk about and update your family emergency communication plan. If you have children, include them in conversations and planning activities.

Have pets? Make sure they are a part of your planning process. Create a pet go-bag to help keep them safe during an emergency. Find helpful tips from FEMA on how to plan for your furry friends.

Older adults often have special needs in a disaster and may depend on medications or other special requirements. If older adults are a part of your social connection, be sure to include them in your preparedness planning efforts.

Emergencies can and will happen, but being ready can minimize the impact they have on the overall well-being of you and your family.

This year, make disaster preparedness part of your New Year's resolution.

February CERT Smoke Signals Update

Boy what a month we had the first week in January. Snow, snow, snow on top of cold, cold, cold! Because of the bad weather, the Decatur County Emergency Management Director activated the Emergency Operation Center to coordinate the flow in information to the City Administrators, City Police, County Administrators, County Sheriff, County Highway, City and County Public Schools and many, many more people. As a part of this activation, he also activated the CERT Team. The CERT Team members available were Ron Day, Charles Suiters, Dave Haas, Jim Boyd and Bill McVay.

The team worked in the EOC on Sunday and Monday and were then dispatched to set up Emergency shelters at Westport on Sunday and then Greensburg Elementary School on Monday night. The Elementary school shelter was open from 10PM Monday to 6AM Tuesday and manned by the CERT Team members.

Also, due to the condition of the roads, some of the volunteer drivers for Meals on Wheels and Bread of Life were unable to work, and the CERT Team was again called to fill in. Thanks to the above mentioned Team Members for the dedication and efforts in the most recent emergency.

Some key information for the next emergency. When a county wide emergency is issued, that causes the Emergency Operation Center to be activated. This is a resource for any of the county residents to report problems, issues, request help etc. To contact the EOC, all you need to do is call **663-2004**. You can also get access to the information using Facebook. The people in the center will then process your needs request and coordinate activities related to it. Examples would be, lost power and need assistance, need emergency fill on propane, reporting dangerous situations like road conditions etc. Use them that is why they are waiting on your call. **Remember 663-2004.**

If you would like to be a member of the CERT Team (18 trained to date, 17 from Lake Santee) let Bill McVay know and he will add your name to the next training session. The training consists of class room work and practical exercises and lasts 24 hours.

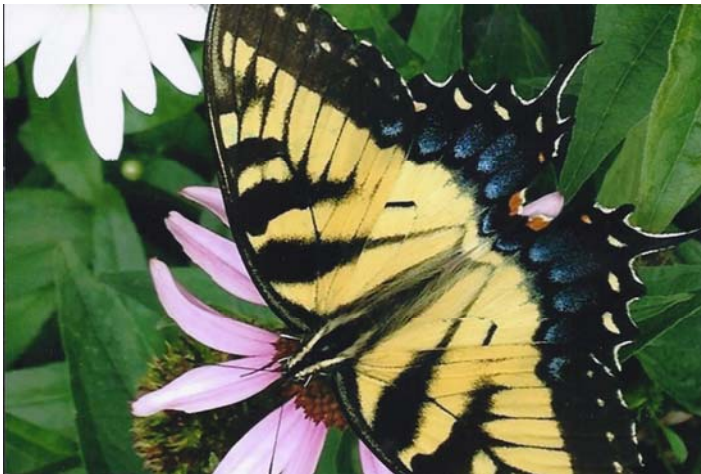

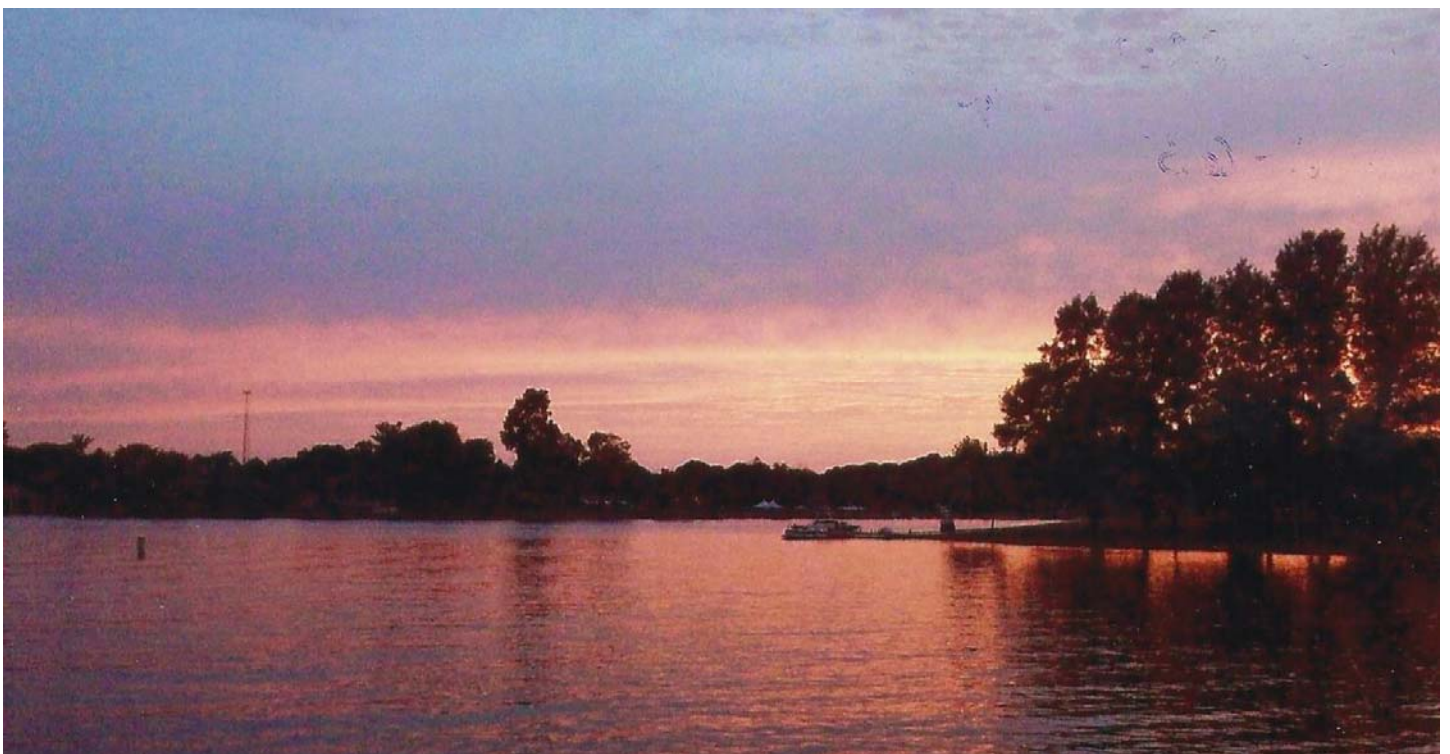

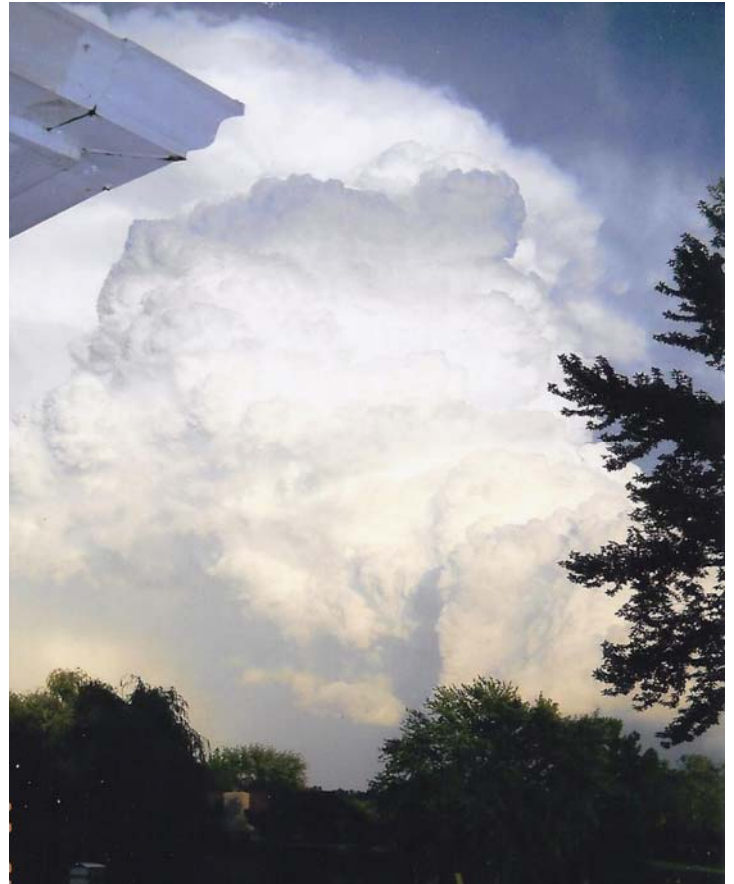

(In spite of what some people say, there are some things left out of the frying pan, such as hog jewels and certain species of fish.)

Near the company where I used to do contract work are two bodies of water best known for their ability to raise Boone and Crockett trophy sized mosquitos. On a noontime stroll I ambled down to the water and watched as carp the size of Volkswagens rooted around in shallow water like hogs in a trough. The sight of them brought memories flooding back of past experiences with these hardy kings of the game fish family. With tears in my eyes I recalled the moments of excitement as I fought one to the bank and marveled at the sleek lines and handsome features of such a noble member of the species *Slimus Disgustus*. Where else could one find such sport for no more than the cost of a half pound of dough balls.

Actually, my first introduction to carp came when a friend asked if I would like to join him in a night of fishing for what I thought was something best taken with a 12 gage shotgun or a small stick of dynamite. At one time I had spent a few days stalking the things in a quarry hole with a bow and arrow with a reel mounted on the bow. I had decided that if I nailed one of the things I would cut the line and leave the fish, arrow and all. Fishing arrows were expensive, but I had been told that retrieving one from a carp was like pulling it out of a thirty year old outhouse. Fortunately for me and the carp I couldn't hit a school bus from ten feet with the thing. So I was spared the need to make a choice. In spite of my misgivings and the shock of discovering that my buddy would stoop to such a lowly state as actually fishing for carp, I accepted. When I asked what we would do with the fish if we caught any he replied, "We'll put them on a stick, roast them over a fire and eat them. I call them carpsicles." He almost lost me there, but after explaining that his neighbor wanted a few for his pond I relaxed. To quell my fears of being exposed to public ridicule he said we would fish at night at a secluded spot on a very large reservoir in an area where the chances of meeting anyone I knew were very remote. 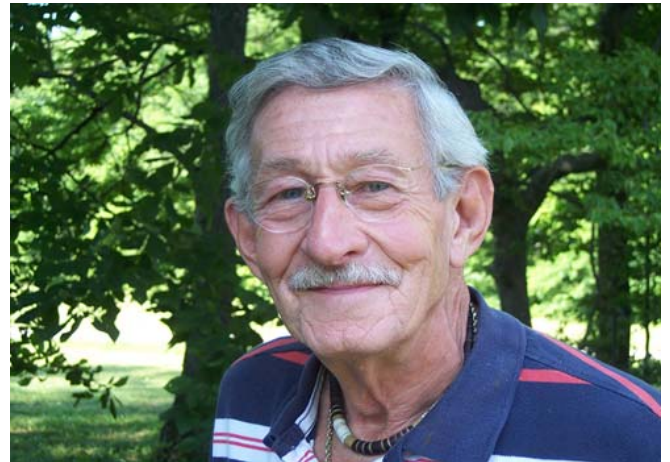

All dates for upcoming events in July, August, and December have been reserved for the community room. Members are looking forward to the many activities and projects scheduled for the year.

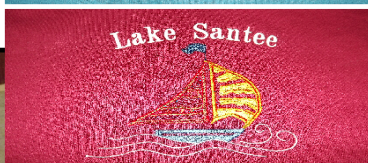

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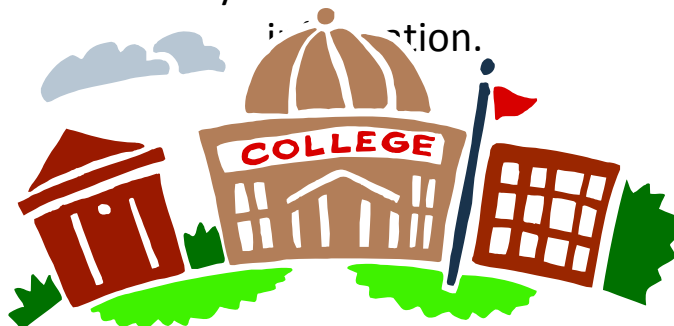

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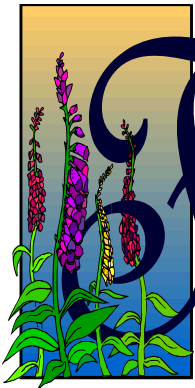

Second Annual Winter Bird Count at Lake Santee

Nine bird counters, Deb Evans, Kim Belter, Sharon Kobeske, Dan Laker, Carol Reger, Betty Gabbard, Kathy Tarzwell, Fae Cutrufelli, and Charm Seright enjoyed four days of spotting and identifying over 1,000 birds from 30 species around the lake. Our count this year showed some significant gains over last year, specifically in the numbers of Canada geese, juncos, mallards, mourning doves, blue jays, American robins, bluebirds, American tree sparrows, song sparrows and cardinals. There were also several sightings of rufous-sided towhees which please birders here. And we have the **first sighting** of a brown creeper to add to our list this year. This small tree crawler spirals its way upward searching for insects and spiders in bark crevices. It is white bellied, brown striped, has a down-curved bill and a long tail it uses for support. This little bird is more easily located in the spring because of its high warbling song. Other favorite species such as blue heron, chickadee, titmouse, American goldfinch, house finch, pileated, red bellied, downy and hairy wood peckers were accounted for as well as some not so favorites as English sparrows and starlings. Only 1 eagle was spotted and that was the day after the count, but we all know there are more here!

b) Functions limited to three hours or less shall be charged \$45.00 rental and \$45.00 damage deposit. This would include meetings, birthday parties, showers, etc.

c) Daytime functions of more than three hours duration and concluding prior to 6:00 p.m. shall be charged \$115.00 rental and \$115.00 damage deposit.

d) Functions beginning after 6:00 p.m. of more than three hours duration, (other than wedding receptions) shall be charged \$125.00 rental and \$125.00 damage deposit.

e) Functions running through the afternoon and continuing past 6:00 p.m. (other than wedding receptions) shall be charged \$175.00 rental and \$175.00 damage deposit.

f) Wedding receptions shall be charged \$235.00 rental and \$235.00 damage deposit.

15.7 DECORATING

a) No nails, staples, tacks, or tape are to be used on walls ceilings, doors, or trim.

b) Extreme caution must be exercised when using candles.

c) If scheduling permits, decorating may be done in advance of reservation time.

15.8 CLEANUP

f) All tables and chairs are to be stored in the designated closets

Your Board Members want your feedback and opinion

If you have followed the LSPOA Board minutes published in the Smoke Signals over the past several months you would have notice a renewed effort to open a secondary entrance into the subdivision on the north end.

This topic was presented the first time in 2010. A survey was conducted to determine interest for the project and informational sessions were held, however the proposal fell short due to lack of member support. In the initial proposal the project was to be funded by the users of the entrance through both construction phases plus for ongoing upkeep.

This renewed effort is based on most of same thoughts as the initial proposal. Those thoughts included but were not limited to improved public safety (emergency vehicle response), easing traffic on Santee Dr. and other Association roads, savings to the school district in pupil transportation costs.

The prior Board had given good consideration to the proposal as presented and in that consideration determined there were not enough members that would contribute to the project in the construction phase nor support the ongoing costs through user fees.

It is still not believed that this project can be self funded.

Prior Boards acknowledged that having an unattended open secondary entrance was not a viable option, knowing this reality required that any secondary entrance would need to be controlled and gated. The current Board also wants to give this renewed effort fair consideration.

The Board is not interested at this time in spending much in additional funds on this project, with all the other current infrastructure projects on the table.

In any case the Board would like to hear your opinion related to this matter. If you have comments, opinions or strong feeling one way or the other please drop a note at the office, contact one of the Directors or the Lake Manager.

2 tbsp. raspberry or strawberry preserves
confectioners' sugar, optional

1. In a bowl, cream butter and sugar. Add egg yolk; mix well. Stir in the flour by hand. On a lightly floured surface, gently knead dough for 2-3 minutes or until thoroughly combined.
2. Roll into 1 inch balls. Place 2 inches apart on greased baking sheets. Using the end of a wooden spoon handle, make an indentation in the center of each. Fill each with 1/4 teaspoon preserves.
3. Bake at 350° for 13-15 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Remove to wire racks. Dust warm cookies with confectioners' sugar if desired. Cool. Yield: about 2 dozen.



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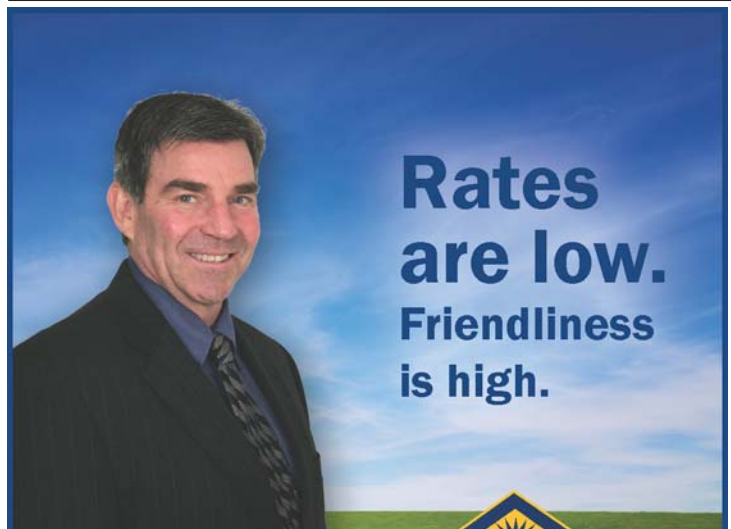
