Indiana State Police Reminds the Public About the Dangers of Meth Lab Trash

With favorable spring weather coming our way, people are taking advantage by walking, jogging and bike riding on our local roadways. The potential exists that some people may come across trash left behind by those who have manufactured methamphetamine (meth). The Indiana State Police Meth Suppression Section wants to remind citizens that this trash may contain chemicals that are toxic, flammable, corrosive, and acidic. The combination of these chemicals could cause an explosion, fire or burns if they come into direct contact with the skin.

The Indiana State Police Meth Suppression Section, have identified some points for the public to keep in mind.

- Meth cooks are using a variety of containers to manufacture their product. A popular container is the one and a half gallon gas can. These cans appear to be new and have been found along the roadside by unknowing people who believe that they have found a new gas can and end up with a working meth lab.
- Other Items to be aware of include battery casings, Ziploc style bags, empty blister packs, and containers (pop-bottles, jars, etc.) that contain a granular material. They may or may not have a tube extending out of the top depending on whether it is a hydrochloric gas generator (HCL) or a one pot reaction. Both of these are extremely hazardous.
- Be aware of any type of cylinder found in an odd place (middle of a field, ditch line, wooded area) that has a modified valve. The valve will typically be modified in some way and will have a bright blue color to it. These cylinders are used to store or transport anhydrous ammonia, which is an extremely dangerous gas when direct contact or inhalation has occurred.

If someone comes across this type of trash, they should not handle it.. Instead, contact the local Indiana State Police Post, which can be found at the following link: <http://www.in.gov/isp/2382.htm> .

(There's only one thing worse than having your mother-in-law pay a surprise visit and announce that she plans to stay a while, and that's to have your gun jam about the time a grizzly starts messing up your hairdo.)

Anyone who indulges in outdoor pastimes has had an incident with equipment that ruins his or her day. For instance, the dog is quivering on a hard point and as you approach, a large cock pheasant explodes from cover. A smooth swing of the shotgun to the shoulder and a deft squeeze of the trigger results in a weak pop of the primer as the shot and wads dribble out of the barrel and fall on the dogs back. As the bird flogs off into the distance you try to explain to the dog that it wasn't your fault. Somehow, the ammo manufacturer had overlooked adding powder to the shell.

I had this happen to me on a shooting range in England while a crowd of locals watched expectantly for a demonstration of the prowess of a "colonist" with a shotgun. The only thing missing to complete their image of me was a coonskin cap, a powder horn dangling from around my neck and a bowie knife stuck in my beaded waist band. Two clays came off the trap, one a batue and the other a regular size field target. Take the batue on the rise, I thought, and then nail the other, larger clay. I jerked the trigger in anticipation of recoil and was rewarded with a "pop" and shot dribbling from the barrel on my shoes. Both clays sailed quietly off into the distance. Red faced, I heard one bystander mutter, "I say, how did we manage to lose that country? Perhaps we should have another go at taking it away from them." To avoid a shootout at Conniston Cold Shooting Club I didn't reply with a remark about the quality of foreign ammo.

Unless you reload your own, an unpowdered round is rare. However, there are other sporting products that could use a little more quality in their manufacture. One incident involving a boat comes to mind. It happened a number of years ago when fiberglass was becoming popular as a hull material. A gentleman had just purchased a speed boat constructed from the new material and was boasting about how the hull was invulnerable to damage. The local game warden (that's what we called them at that time) said he didn't believe it. When the owner said prove it, he drew his revolver and blew a .38 caliber sized hole through the bottom of the hull. A little drastic, but the point was made. Don't mess with the DNR.

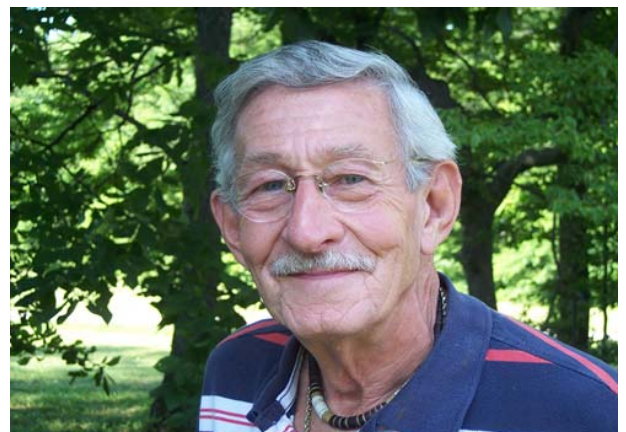
Aside from a few quality problems with a particular brand of fly rod, I believe the producers of waders can and should make them totally leak proof. Nothing ruins a day of fishing faster than suddenly realizing that the cold feeling creeping up your legs isn't because your heart has stopped. Waders should be made with an

inner lining of the same material used for high altitude weather balloons. Then, a layer of finely woven steel mesh overlaid by another layer of bullet proof Kevlar topped with an inch thick layer of Goodyear rubber. Such a pair of waders with a sealed helmet and an air supply would allow a fisherman to expand his or her territory to include bottom walking and fishing in such places as the Bermuda Triangle and the Marianas Trench. Not only would they prevent tears and holing, they could withstand the tremendous pressures at greater depths. The primary objective would be to avoid having the fisherman waddle out of the stream looking like the Sta-Puff marshmallow man.

While great strides have been made to spin casting reels, fly reels remain essentially the same mechanically as the earliest models. A spool on a spindle inside a frame with a crank handle. Of course, automatic reels with a spring that rewinds the line at the touch of a lever are a clever innovation, but they have their drawbacks. Unless the user develops a deft touch in using it, the thing will rewind the line in at warp speed until the fly reaches the first guide on the rod. There, the fly snaps off and the line winds into the reel where the end can't be retrieved until you dismantle the #@\$\$% thing. And they call that progress.

I had one of the demonic things and was working the fly into a pool that looked like it had to be the home of a world record something. Tense as a bow string I watched the fly as it floated into a perfect position. Suddenly the water boiled and I instinctively heaved back on the rod, but not before I accidentally hit the rewind lever. Whatever it was that struck would have had to be equipped with a small turbojet attached to its tail to catch the fly as it whistled toward me at Mach 4. It's not a pretty sight to watch a grown man throw a temper tantrum while standing in waist deep, fast flowing ice water. Why can't someone develop an auto-wind fly reel that works like a computer? When you push the rewind lever a message pops up on a little screen that asks, "Do you really want to do this?"

What does the future hold? Will we fish with microchip controlled lures that capture fish without the need for a line? Even with such exotic baits, the fisherman may go home empty handed after the batteries in his lures have gone dead.

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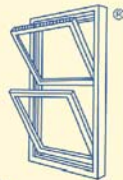
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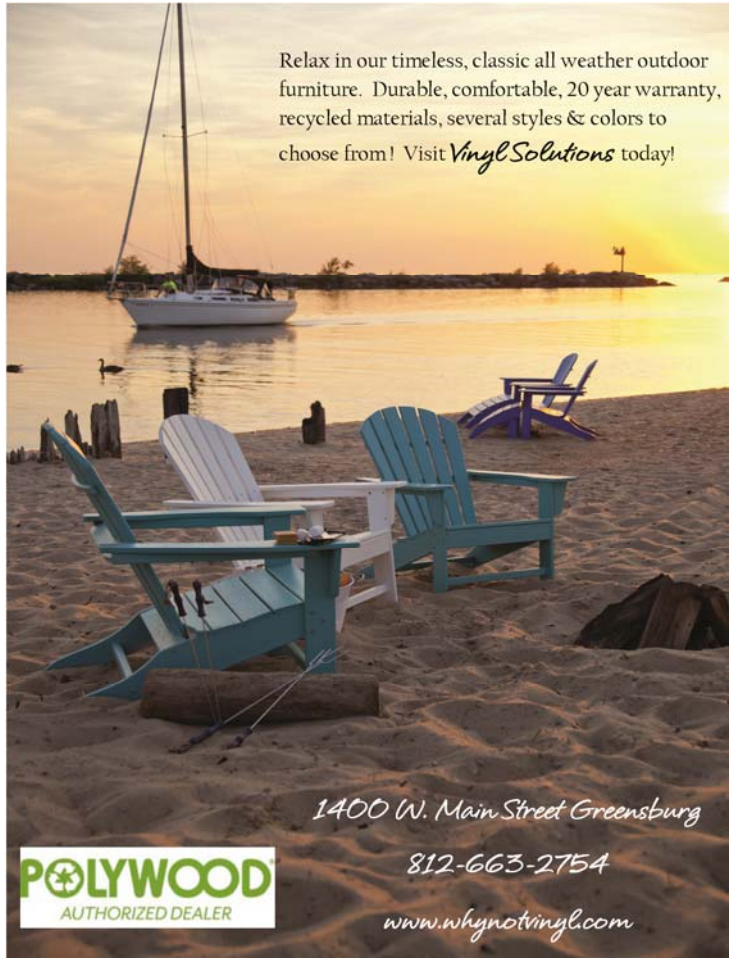

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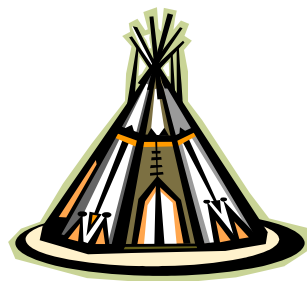

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A MUST READ FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR

Spring and summer time is here, please keep in mind these severe weather safety tips. Sign up for text messages at nixle.com to receive severe weather updates for your area. We also work to keep our facebook page up to date with weather updates. Easiest way to get to our facebook page is through the department web page (ClarksburgFireDept.org), down on the left side of the page is a link to the Clarksburg Fire facebook page. Be sure to like to the page to return any time you want from your own facebook page.

Lightning is unpredictable and dangerous.

While lightning fatalities have decreased over the past 30 years, it is still one of the top three storm-related killers in the United States.

Outdoors

Most lightning deaths and injuries occur when people are caught outdoors.

- At the first sign of lightning or thunder, seek shelter.
- Do not resume outdoor activities for at least 30 minutes after last observed lightning or thunder.
- Avoid the following areas: water, high ground, large open areas, isolated trees, and all metal objects or electrical wires.

If Someone is Struck by Lightning

- Have someone dial 9-1-1 immediately.
- People struck by lightning carry NO electrical charge and can be safely attended to immediately.
- Give first aid. If breathing has stopped, begin rescue breathing. If the heart has stopped beating, a trained person should give CPR. If the person has a pulse and is breathing, look and care for other possible injuries.
- Stay with the victim until medical professionals arrive.

Thunderstorms are very prevalent during the summer months in Indiana. They can produce large hail, flash floods, heavy rain, lightning, strong winds, and tornadoes. Thunderstorms can last only a few minutes, but have the strength and power to cause a great amount of damage.

Thunderstorm Watches:

Conditions are favorable for thunderstorm to appear.

Thunderstorm Warnings:

A thunderstorm is occurring or about to occur in your area.

During a Thunderstorm

- If a thunderstorm is coming postpone or cancel outdoor activity.
- Do **NOT** go near tall trees or any other tall objects.
- Seek shelter inside a building or in a hardtop vehicle, but don't touch any of the metal inside.
- Do **NOT** use the telephone. Stay away from other electronic devices, bare metal, and water.
- Do **NOT** go near downed power lines.
- Keep your eye on the sky and listen to weather reports on the radio or TV.

- If caught out in the middle of a large body of water, return to shore as soon as possible. Get off the water immediately.
- When caught in the middle of an open field: If walking with others stay a minimum of 10 feet apart, keep low and move quickly to seek shelter. If there is no shelter lay in a ditch or get to the lowest place around.

Tornadoes are violent rotating cylinders of air that can reach speeds in excess of 300 mph, be more than a mile wide, and cover up to around 50 miles during their short path of destruction. Tornadoes can cause millions of dollars worth of damage and rip buildings off their foundations leaving only debris in their wake. They can appear suddenly and with little warning.

Tornado Watch: Conditions are right to have a tornado. Maintain a close look out for changes in the sky and stay tuned to local weather stations.

Tornado Warning: This means there is an actual tornado reported or radar indicates one could develop within a few minutes. Seek shelter quickly.

During a Tornado:

- Basements, inner rooms of a house, and storm cellars provide the best protection.
- Stay away from exterior walls, windows, and doors. Stay in the center of the room.
- If you are in your car do **NOT** try and outrun the tornado because it can switch direction and can cover lots of ground quickly.
- Get out of vehicle and go into a strong building if possible. If not, lie flat in a ditch or low area and cover your head.
- Do **NOT** go under overpasses, wind speeds actually increase under them and can suck you out!
- If you live in a mobile home, get out **IMMEDIATELY**. Take shelter in a building with a strong foundation.
- Listen to radio or watch TV so you can be alerted about your current situation.

SPRING!!!!!!

Spring is finally here and is living up to all its potential! Mild temperatures, sunshine, some rain to keep things growing and birds nesting in all the appropriate and some unusual places. A pair of Chickadees has adopted the bluebird box and built the sweetest moss nest in it. She had three mini jellybean sized eggs at the last count. Another report has a white breasted nuthatch nesting in a blue bird box. When a new blue bird nesting box was placed just 20 feet away it was occupied by a pair of blue birds within 12 hours. On a not so agreeable note, common grackles are trying to occupy the wood duck box that already has three duck eggs in it. Despite removal of the bird nest twice daily the shy wood ducks have not retaken the box. Hard to say how long this drama at the lake front will last. Suffice it to say, there may not be a wood duck nesting in the box but there definitely will NOT be a common grackle nest!

Wildflowers in Bloom

Because of the cold winter and late spring, the second weekend in April showed some early blooms at the 9th annual Spring Wildflower Walk at The Nature Habitat. We saw a rare bloom on the skunk cabbage for this late in the spring. Bloodroot, Cut-leaved toothwort, Dog tooth violet (aka trout lily, fawn lily and adder's tongue), Dutchman's breeches, Harbinger of Spring, Hepatica, Rue-anemone, Spring beauty, blue and yellow Violets, and Wild Ginger also were in bloom. Showing their buds were May apples, False Solomon's seal, Solomon's seal, Sweet William, and Trillium. By now the Jack-in-the-Pulpits, white Violets and wild Geranium are probably showing themselves. We have a new sighting to add to our list of 36 identifiable wildflowers at The Nature Habitat. Foliage for Puttyroot orchid, also known as Adam-and-Eve was spotted for the first time. We'll be looking for that to bloom in May and June. There is always something new at The Nature Habitat. Thanks to the maintenance crew there is new picnic table available. Take a break, take your lunch; relax in the restful peace of the woods.

Making the case for planting natives

April and May are prime time for gardening, yard work and home maintenance just because it feels so good to be outside! This year, as in the past and still important, is the choice of native plants for our gardens and landscapes. Native plants are hardier and healthier for wildlife and the ecosystem. They are also a better choice because they require less care, water and chemicals to maintain them. Here is a short list of plants that produce fruits and seeds that will attract numerous bees, butterflies, birds and small mammals to your backyard habitat:

Annuals: Sunflowers, marigolds, zinnias, dill and parsley.

Grasses: Big bluestem, little bluestem, sideoats grama, switch grass, prairie dropseed.

Perennials: Liatris “blazing star”, wild columbine, jewelweed, native phlox, native honeysuckle, cardinal flower, milkweed, aster, purple coneflower, black-eyed Susan, joe-pye weed, goldenrod, vervain, trumpet creeper, sweet violet, mint, sage, thyme and lavender.

Shrubs: Dogwood, viburnum, spicebush, common chokeberry, beauty berry

Trees: White pine, tulip tree, red maples, Serbian spruce, Washington hawthorns, serviceberry.

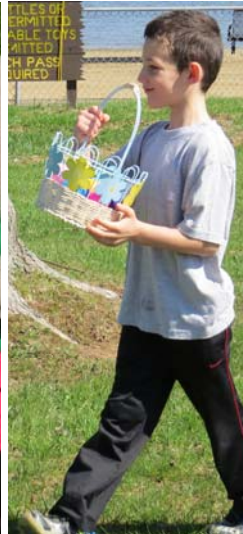
Exotic invasives to eradicate: Star of Bethlehem, purple loosestrife, multiflora rose, Japanese honeysuckle, autumn and Russian olive, burning bush euonymous, periwinkle, creeping Charlie and creeping Jenny to name a few. These plants grow so densely they crowd out the native plants, use up the water and nutrients from the soil, and do not provide nutrition for a large number of wildlife species.

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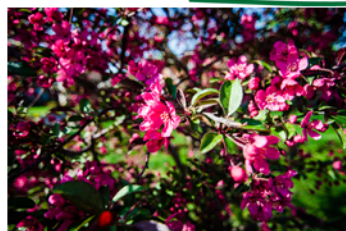

Brad received a ruling from the court regarding Matt Osterling as plaintiff for Quiet Title on lot 427 obtained a default judgment and has clear title and he will be working on that structure to make it inhabitable.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Rules & Regulations – Doug Lecher

Doug presented the 2nd reading of the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations, Building section (Section 12) as follows:

12.2 Building permits issued by the Association are required for houses, garages, outbuildings, additions, roofing, re-siding, swimming pools, fences, docks, decks, communication dishes larger than 36", culverts, filling or tiling of road ditches, gazebos, lake walls, shoreline protection, dredging, dog pens and any other structure. Many of the aforementioned also require a building permit from the appropriate county. A form is available at the Lake Santee Office for submitting permit requests and it specifies the documents and/or drawings required to apply for a specific permit. All structures must conform to the Subdivision restrictions. At the discretion of the building committee, periodic and/or final inspection may be made of the construction, to insure compliance.

12.3 Access to all property shall be by an approved driveway culvert. A building permit is required prior to installation and culvert size will be determined by the building committee to handle water flow requirements.

12.5 A complete set of construction plans, including floor plans, exterior elevations, and a list of materials for foundation, siding and roofing shall be required for houses or house additions. Houses will not be approved without one or more of the following features: more than four corners, one or more roof valleys, dormers, or a covered porch of at least 100 square feet. The Building Committee will not approve two houses of similar exterior design in one area.

12.21 When connecting an unattached exterior structure to a main dwelling the enclosure must meet all standard building requirements for roofs, foundations and siding.

12.22 Removal or tear down of existing structure must be completed to grade level and any basement or crawlspace filled to grade level. All debris must be removed within 90 days.

Angel Hocker made motion to approve the rules changes on 2nd reading and Randy seconded the motion. Motion carried and moved to 3rd reading. Charm Seright asked who the committee is and how much power they have. The Building Committee consists of Polly Ann Fox as Chairman, Brandon Litmer, Brad Jones, and Richard Veach as ex-officio. It was explained that the purpose of the Building Committee is to ensure that members are in compliance with the building rules, land covenants and deed restrictions..

Randy Ostendorf made motion to approve the 3rd and final reading of the rules changes. Polly Ann Fox seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Recreation

Angel Hocker announced the Easter Egg Hunt will be April 19, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. Mrs. Jarman and the Girl Scouts will be handling that event. They normally expect about 100-125 children for the event.

Attention Absentee Home Owners

Homeowners would be well advised to turn off their water while away. Homeowners are prohibited from operating the water meter valve or removing and/or loosening the meter to drain lines. All customers are required by the rules to have their own valves in place to valve off and drain their homes as necessary. If you want the District to also turn off the meter valve, we will be happy to do so, however the District will not be held liable for meter valves that are not 100% tight. You are advised not to depend solely on the meter valve. The charge for valving is \$10.00 during regular work hours of 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM, \$20.00 after hours. The same charges apply to valves turned on. The District cannot turn on water to a home unless the customer has a valve closed to protect the home or a responsible adult is present.

1. Roll Call

Scott Gibbs called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Trustees present were: Scott Gibbs, Clair Fredrickson, Paul Gosnell, Kathy Tarzwell, Jim Hornig, and Greg Montgomery. Also attending was Brad Jones, RWWD Administrator.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from February 20, 2014
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Registers of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Registers of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Kathy Tarzwell and seconded by Clair Fredrickson to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Operators Report

- a. Sewer Status Report – In Brandon’s absence, Brad reported that the plant is operating well with no issues and all tests are normal.
- b. Water Status Report – In Brandon’s absence, Brad reported that the plant is operating well with no issues and all tests are normal.
- c. Administrator Status Report – Brad reported:
 - i. The District received a letter from LSPOA Board President Dick Veach requesting relief of approximately a \$51.00 per month access fee for a water hydrant located near the ATM in the main parking lot. Mr. Veach was in attendance and explained that the LSPOA did not use this hydrant for any activity at the Lake. It was agreed to review the request.
 - ii. Brad has been working on the State Board of Accounts annual on-line filings, including cleaning up some past filings. Brad has had several conversations with the SBOA and they are working through the past issues together. Once the past filings are cleaned up, the present and future filings will be easier to complete.
 - iii. Brad received an inquiry from Dunn & Bradstreet regarding the District’s credit worthiness. Brad feels this is just an attempt to sell us something.

4. Committee Reports

- a. Board Member Guide Committee
 - i. Officer Manuals – No update.
 - ii. Board Training Topic – There will be training at each monthly meeting.
 1. Open Door Law and Public Access – Three ring binders were distributed to the Board Members to organize their Training Materials. Scott hi-lighted several points of interest of the Open Door Law that defines what a meeting is, when and where meetings may occur, and what can or cannot be discussed. Access to public records was also reviewed. He then encouraged

the Board to read through all of the materials in the binder to fully understand this Law.
