Official Rules

1. All Lake Santee rules and bylaws will be followed.
2. There will be a mandatory meeting FIFTEEN (15) minutes prior to the start of the tournament at the Lake Santee Main Beach Shelter. Those teams not entered prior to the meeting will be disqualified unless prior arrangements have been made with tournament official(s).
3. Boat positions will be determined at the mandatory meeting by a number draw.
The start will be a continual "ooze off" of boats by the position drawn.
4. A mandatory boat check will be conducted prior to the start of the tournament.
All boats must be equipped with an aerated livewell capable of sustaining a limit of bass.
5. Safe boating must be observed at all times. Each participant is required to wear a USCG approved life preserver and the kill switch should be working properly any time the combustion engine is in operation prior to and during tournament hours.
6. Only largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted (Kentucky) will be counted towards the daily limit of five (5) bass per team. Only artificial baits may be utilized in competition, including pork type trailers.
7. Only bass measuring sixteen (16) inches or longer will be weighed. The official board will be the Golden Rule. No short fish will be counted towards daily limit. The penalty for weighing short fish will be the weight of short fish plus two (2) ounces per fish deducted from the total of the legal fish that are weighed in.
8. No dead bass will be counted. *All bass must be released in healthy condition. Any bass which fails to swim away upon release will be scored as a dead fish and the weight of that fish plus eight (8) ounces will be deducted from that teams' remaining weight.*
9. Participants will not be allowed to leave the boat during tournament hours. Participants may briefly leave the boat for an exigent emergency or answer the "call of nature".
10. All ties will be determined by combining the prizes and dividing it equally between the respective teams. All protests must be made in writing within **TEN (10)** minutes of tournament conclusion.
11. No cheating will be tolerated and contestants may only use artificial baits during competition.
12. Competitors are expected to follow a high standard of sportsmanship, safety, and conservation. Alcohol and abused drugs will not be consumed during tournament hours.
13. The Tournament will be a two (2) man team style format. At least one member of each team must be an L.S.P.O.A. member in good standing. Members may fish alone and be considered a team.

BASS FISHING TOURNAMENT JUNE 14, 2015

Well, just when one believes the bass fishing at Lake Santee can't seem to get any better, a tournament like the event on June 14th comes along! What a weigh in! For those folks who didn't come down to watch the teams weigh in their catches, you definitely missed quite the show.

Sixteen teams took place in the contest and, while dock space at the Main Beach was extremely tight, fifteen of those teams managed to bring in over 156 pounds of bass with a total of 55 keepers to the scales. That equates to an average weight of 2 lb. 13 oz. per bass. Wow... Also ten of the teams' catches weighed over 10 pounds and six bass over 4 pounds were caught, including Brianna Salemmé's 4.1b 7 oz giant! Brianna is Gary Salemmé's teenage daughter who has competed with her dad in our events for the last 3 years, in every type of weather imaginable. So the next time you hear someone say it's too hot, cold, windy, rainy, humid, or whatever, to participate- remember, if Brianna can do it, there are no excuses why you can't fish too!!! Like stated above, those who witnessed the weigh in saw Lake Santee at its finest and every bass weighed in was released alive back into the lake!

The large crowd at the weigh in saw father/son duo of Butch and Marco Mikesell garner first place with a five bass limit which totaled 17.22 lbs. While Rob Merriman and T.J. Edwards missed their limit, bringing only four bass, the pair caught the right kind with two fish over 4 lbs. including the day's Big Bass, a 4.62 trophy. Their total of 15.16 lbs also landed them in second place overall. Another father/son team, Tim and Carson Tennell rounded out the Top 3 with a limit of bass which weighed 13.62.

In addition to our regular event, a USA Bassin' sanctioned event was held in conjunction with ten of our teams opting to take part. Each team gained valuable points towards the year end championship which culminates in one team taking home a brand new \$50,000 Ranger bass boat.

Two lucky teams were fortunate enough to take home prizes from the drawings provided by Jack and Betty at Anglers World in Greenfield, IN. In addition, our winners and Big Bass angler, were presented beautiful plaques provided by Jackie Mitchell and all the fine folks at Acra's Buy Right Auto in Greensburg. Thank you to both of these wonderful businesses for all their generous support!

Our Lake Santee continues to produce these kinds of tremendous catches and weights because of not only careful, well thought out, professional management practices but also by our fishermen practicing true conservation methods. Please follow their lead and **PRACTICE CATCH AND RELEASE** on all of Lake Santee's bass and remember to take a child fishing. Until next time...

MEMBERS INTRODUCTION AND COMMENTS

Members were asked to introduce themselves and given the opportunity to express comments.

Michael Dora thanked the board for the opening of the North gate.

A member spoke concerning a couple of issues. First of all, his mailbox is continually left open and he believes he is losing mail. He experienced this problem often enough that he went and bought a locking mailbox. Dick agreed to do so and expressed his appreciation of Mr. Stenger's issues and stated that we would be discussing this within the night's meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Rules & Regulations – Polly Ann Fox

The rules and regulations committee had two rules they have been working on, one concerning tree houses and one concerning the new amphitheater. The committee is putting a hold on the tree house rules for further discussion. Polly gave a first reading of the rules concerning the amphitheater for board approval and discussion.

Amphitheater

16.1 WHO MAY USE:

- a) The Association Board may reserve the Amphitheater for events as needed.
- b) Lake Santee clubs and organizations may reserve the Amphitheater for Board approved events.
- c) Members in good standing may reserve the Amphitheater for approved activities.
- d) The Amphitheater is not available to the general public, unless approved by the Board of Directors.

16.2 ACTIVITIES PERMITTED

- a) All activities shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, as well as within the Rules and Regulations of the Association.
- b) Any activity judged by the Board to be destructive to the facilities or to be otherwise improper shall not be permitted.
- c) The Board of Directors reserves the right to refuse any individual, club, or organization the right to use the Amphitheater.
- d) Any activity at which food, drink, or other items are offered for sale, or at which admission or cover charges are contemplated must have prior approval of the Board.

16.3 FACILITIES AVAILABLE

- a) The Amphitheater is hexagon 31' at the widest x 15'6" maximum depth in size, or 305.78 square feet.
- b) Handicap accessible restrooms are available within the Beach restroom.

16.4 HOURS

- a) Sunday through Thursday: all activities shall cease prior to 10:00 p.m. (cleanup may continue quietly).
- b) Friday and Saturday: All activities shall cease prior to 12:00 midnight (cleanup may continue quietly).
- c) The hours may be extended by the Board of Directors for special functions.

16.5 FEES & DEPOSITS

- a) All functions of the Association, their designated committees, and Lake Santee clubs and organizations may be permitted without charge, unless special permit fees are required.
- b) Functions limited to three hours or less shall be charged \$45.00 rental and \$45.00 damage deposit, plus any applicable permit or legally required fees.
- c) Daytime functions of more than three hours duration and concluding prior to 6:00 p.m. shall be charged \$115.00 rental and \$115.00 damage deposit, plus any applicable permit or legally required fees.
- d) Functions beginning after 6:00 p.m. of more than three hours duration shall be charged \$125.00 rental and \$125.00 damage deposit, plus any applicable permit or legally required fees.
- e) Functions running through the afternoon and continuing past 6:00 p.m. shall be charged \$175.00 rental and \$175.00 damage deposit plus any applicable permit or legally required fees.
- f) All monies shall be collected by personnel in the Lake Santee Office.
- g) Damage deposit will be refunded within 48 hours of function, but not until the facilities have been thoroughly inspected. Deposit will have to be picked up at the Lake Santee Office or received by mail as requested.
- h) If inspection reveals incomplete cleanup including outside trash containers, and time allows, renter will be contacted for immediate follow up action. Otherwise, cleanup will be completed by lake personnel who will be paid with all or part of the damage deposit as necessary.

i) If inspection reveals damage exceeding normal wear and tear, renter will be contacted to discuss and view damage. All or part of the damage deposit will be applied to replace items or repair items damaged as deemed necessary by the Lake Office personnel or the Board.

16.6 SCHEDULING

- a) All scheduling shall be done by personnel in the Lake Santee Office during regular office hours.
- b) A calendar of events and reservations will be available in the office.
- c) The Association Board, and Lake Santee clubs, and organizations may schedule the Amphitheater up to one year in advance.
- d) Members may reserve the Amphitheater up to six months in advance.
- e) A contract must be completed and signed at the time a reservation is made requiring a rental fee. A copy of the contract and rules will be provided to the renter.
- f) The rental fee is due at the time of contract signing and the damage deposit is due 48 hours prior to the approved event.
- g) Full refunds of advance rental will be given for cancellations made fourteen (14) days or more prior to the date reserved. Within the fourteen days of the reserved date, refunds will be given only when cancellation is due to uncontrollable circumstances. The decision to refund is to be made by the Lake Santee Lake personnel or the Board.

16.7 DECORATING

- a) No nails, staples, tacks, or tape are to be used on walls ceilings, or trim.
- b) No open flames will be used in or around the Amphitheater
- c) If scheduling permits, decorating may be done in advance of reservation time.

16.8 CLEANUP

- a) The Amphitheater and surrounding area shall be cleaned. The cleanliness of each should meet or surpass the conditions prior to use.
- b) The area surrounding the Amphitheater must be policed for litter resulting from the function.
- c) All trash must be removed prior to leaving the area of the Amphitheater, and disposed of by persons in charge.
- d) Final cleanup may be completed the following morning if prior approval is received, no events are scheduled and cleanup is completed by 10:00 am.
- e) Trash bags and cleaning supplies are the responsibility of the renter.
- f) Follow the prepared checklist when cleaning.

16.9 EQUIPMENT USAGE

- a) Tables, chairs, and other equipment shall not be removed from the community room for use in connection with the Amphitheater.

16.10 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a) Amphitheater hours require the presence of a responsible adult supervisor.
- b) The member scheduling the rental function must attend that function.
- c) No wet swimsuits will be permitted in the Amphitheater

- e) No pets are allowed.
- f) No minors will be permitted without adult supervision.
- g) Any member misusing the Amphitheater or allowing misuse of the Amphitheater shall be denied future use of the facilities for a period to be determined by the Board

16.11 ENFORCEMENT OF THE COMMUNITY ROOM RULES & REGULATIONS

- a) Enforcement is the primary responsibility of the sponsoring organization or member.
- b) Enforcement may be by any Board Member, Lake Santee employee, Lake Santee Security, or member of the office staff
- c) Where punitive action is deemed necessary by any of the above or the Association Board of Directors, enforcement shall be as provided for in the Association By-laws, under RULES, REGULATIONS AND LEGAL COMMITTEE.

The rules were confirmed for first reading on a motion by Carol Goodwin and a second by Mike Cutrufelli. The rules were created to be similar to the community room with some additions that go along with the Department of Homeland Security concerning outside events.

Recreation – Mike Cutrufelli

Mike announced that the 50th is upon us! He also modeled the t-shirts that board members and sponsors have received.

The time capsule plaque was available to view. Mike announced plans for what will go into the capsule, approximately 40-45 items.

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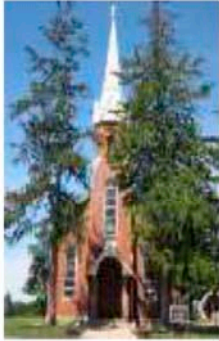

1. Roll Call

Scott Gibbs called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Scott Gibbs, Clair Fredrickson, Jim Hornig, Greg Montgomery, Ed Fox, Kathy Tarzwell, and Paul Gosnell. Also attending were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator and Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from April 16, 2015
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

After a quick review of the payment for cost of re-financing our bonds, Kathy made a motion to approve the consent items as presented. Clair seconded the motion. Motion carried.

3. Operator's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report: Brandon reported that the sewer plant was operating normally with no issues. The replacement testing meter (for BOD) has been delivered and is working well.
- b. Water Status Report: Brandon reported that the granular activated carbon (GAC) has been changed out and all went well. Samples have been sent off for confirmation testing. The water plant is operating normally. Manganese test results are up slightly, but still within limits – increased manganese in the water results in a slight cloudiness. Brandon is working to reduce the manganese.
- c. Upcoming Conferences / Training Classes: There are no relevant conferences at this time. Scott stressed the importance for Jesse to participate in a license test prep course this summer to be ready for the test in November.

4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report: Brad reported there were 5 valve turns, 5 shut-offs with 1 still off, 122 ACHs, and 15 credit card payments this month.
- b. Write-Offs: There were two homes with past due bills. Lots 737 for \$256.99 and 1105 for \$137.99. Both past owners had moved and did not leave a forwarding address. Both homes have new owners. A motion was made by Ed and seconded by Jim to write off these 2 accounts. Motion carried. Brad will continue to try collecting from each of the past property owners.
- c. Correspondence: Brad received a letter from realtor Leon Crowe concerning Lot 364, stating the sewer was backing up into the house. Maintenance investigated and found that the electricity to the pump had been turned off in the house, not allowing the pump to operate. Brad received a request from Cincinnati Insurance to update our information as part of the annual review – Brad provided.

5. Attorney's Report: None at this time.

6. Committee Reports

- a. Board Member Guide Committee
 - i. Board Training Topic – None this month.

7. Old Business

- a. Napoleon Water Update: Ed met with Napoleon Rural Water Corporation (NRWC) this past month and they have indicated they are very interested in a cross-connect with RWW. The cross-connect with an adjacent utility would provide water to our distribution system in the event of a catastrophic event to the water plant. It was decided that Brandon would meet with NRWC to discuss the specifics of how the cross-connect would work, where it should be located, and determining the distances involved. NRWC is already connected with Decatur County Water and has gone through this process before, so Ed will ask for a copy of their agreement with Decatur County Water to have Anne review. Scott reminded everyone to not make any commitments until the details are known, Anne has reviewed any agreements, and the costs associated with the cross-connect are determined and approved.
- b. RWW Property Sale Options: This subject was tabled until more information is available on the LSPOA's long term plans for the north gate.

8. New Business

- a. Annual Drinking Water Quality Report: Brandon is working on this report and will have it ready for mailing by the end of June.
- b. Lake Santee 50th Anniversary 6/13 – Plant Open House: The Water Plant will be open for tours from 2 to 4 P.M. Greg and Ed volunteered to give the tours.

Homeowners Pumps

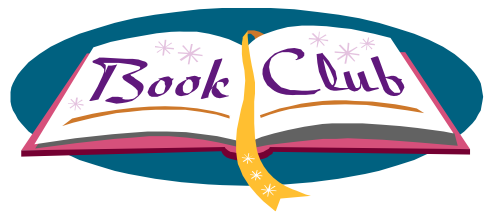
Your grinder pump is not a garbage disposal. The following items should not be put in your system: Glass metal, diapers, socks, rags, cloth, plastics, sanitary napkins, tampons, explosives, flammable materials, lubricating oils or grease, strong chemicals, gasoline, sand, gravel, fish scales, cleaning fluids, pesticides, herbicides and toxic chemicals. The District owns the grinder station and customers are not permitted to open the tank or control panel.



If the red light on the electric box for your grinder pump is on, it means your pump is not working properly. During regular business hours call the office at 527-2943. After regular hours call 560-1157 if you see your light or your neighbors' light on.

A district employee will respond promptly. Also remember, there is an ordinance that prohibits the planting of trees, flowers, shrubs or other plantings within five feet of the station to allow accessibility. In addition no plantings shall be placed on the side of the pump facing the nearest road to promote visibility of the visual alarm from the roadway. Painting of the control panel or pump tank is prohibited.
