

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

LEVELS OF HALOACETIC ACIDS ABOVE DRINKING WATER STANDARDS FOR LAKE SANTEE RWWD

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. The results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets EPA's health standards. The results that we received for Haloacetic Acids for the first and second quarters of 2016 show that our system currently exceeds the standard(s), or Maximum Contaminant Level(s) (MCL). The MCL for Haloacetic Acids is 60 ug/L. As of March 31, 2016 our locational running annual average was 66.3 ug/L and as of June 30, 2016, our locational running annual average was 63.1 ug/L.

What should I do?

You do not need to use an alternative (e.g., bottled) water supply. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

What does this mean?

Some people who drink trihalomethanes (THM) in excess of the MCL over many years may experience problems with their liver, kidneys, or central nervous system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer. Some people who drink water containing haloacetic acids (HAA) in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What Happened? What is being done?

Our running annual average is above the MCL due to the two samples from 2015 that were higher than normal because we were bypassing our carbon tanks at the water plant. We did have one sample location with a result above the MCL in May 2016. We are currently working with IDEM and Water Solutions Unlimited to maximize our treatment process so we can deliver the highest quality water possible. We anticipate being back in compliance during the next monitoring period in August 2016.

The District offers ACH payment options

You may have seen the flyers in the Smoke Signals about ACH payment options. Or, you may have noticed the RWWD's informational table set up during the July 4th festivities to promote ACH enrollment. The District is actively trying to educate customers about this payment option to easily pay your water/sewer bill electronically. After you are set up, your payment is made automatically every month without you having to remember to mail it, or drop it off, or make sure you have stamps this month, etc. Over 140 customers currently take advantage of this program and we would like to reach 200 yet this year. Stop by or call the office and ask how you can get signed up.



Public Notice - Additional Information

The EPA requires the RWWD to sample four times per year for trihalomethanes (THM) and haloacetic acids (HAA), which are disinfection by products. We collect samples from two different locations in February, May, August and November. The average of the samples collected in these four different months has to be below 80 ug/L for trihalomethanes and 60 ug/L for haloacetic acids. We have maintained an average below 80 ug/L for trihalomethanes. Our average did exceed 60 ug/L for haloacetic acids. As we stated in our previous newsletters we were having problems with our granular activated carbon from May through November in 2015. Going forward, as we receive lower test results and the older, higher test results are no longer included in the annual average calculation, the HAA average should return to below 60 and we should stop receiving these Public Notices from IDEM. As always, feel free to call the office or Brandon with any questions or concerns.

On Sunday, June 26th, we held the third event of the 2016 regular season and twenty teams turned out to take part. The father/son duo of Matt and Scott Perkins surpassed everyone with a five bass limit which totaled 18.98 lbs. Second place went to another father and son team, Butch and Marco Mikesell, who brought five keeper bass to the scales which went 15.68 lbs. Rounding out third place was the husband/wife team of Ron and Stacey Tuley with five quality fish which weighed 15.37 lbs. The Big Bass of the event went to Bob Delay and Joe Fuentes with a 6.35 giant. Congratulations to all of our anglers on a great day of fishing at Lake Santee!

In addition, to help kick off the Fourth of July weekend, we held our annual Lake Santee Bass Tournament TNT Celebration Event, a 3 hour, winner take all derby where the anglers fished for just a three bass limit. This tournament was held Friday, July 1st from 6 until 9 PM. Ten teams took part in the evening's fun, with residents Chuck Sieg and Paul Bruns taking the prize with three bass totaling over 9 1/2 pounds. Great job guys!

An interesting statistic in these two events was that there were ELEVEN largemouth bass weighed in over 4 lbs, with a few of those being over 5 lbs. each. Please help us sustain our phenomenal fishery by following our tournament anglers' lead and *PRACTICE CATCH AND RELEASE* on all of Lake Santee's bass! Also, don't forget to take a child fishing when the opportunity arises!

We are also going to address an issue which has unfortunately become way too common on waterways everywhere, especially our own Lake Santee... <u>Courtesy</u>. After speaking with numerous folks which have witnessed this, it seems as though people are operating their boats without much, if any, consideration of others. It has become obvious that many, but not all, boaters, both pleasure and fishermen, seem to operate their vessel in complete oblivion to others who they share the water with. Our Lake Santee, while a beautiful watershed, is rather small, considering the amount of traffic which utilize it each day. Take time to review ALL the lake rules. Just because our lake doesn't have marked lanes like a highway, does not mean one should drive haphazardly about the lake or when entering the coves. All that is needed is for some to put themselves in others' shoes, or boats, in this case. Take time to be observant of how big of a wake your boat is producing. Is that wake going to affect others adversely? Are you driving your boat faster than idle speed within 200 feet (That's 2/3rds of a football field folks!) of the shore? If so, <u>SLOW DOWN</u> and give the other boats some room. If you decide to pull into a small cove and fish or swim, are you being courteous to others who might be there before you? Courtesy and communication are the key. We all have to operate our boats in a safe manner, making sure to look ahead of us, farther than just the bow of our boat!

Oh, and if you have never thought about these type issues, you are quite possibly part of the problem... Just saying...

WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH



Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.

Zebra Mussel (Dreissena polymorpha)



Zebra mussels (*Dreissena polymorpha*) are prolific invaders that cost the U.S. billions of dollar each year. These small mussels from Eurasia can clog water intakes and damage equipment by attaching to boat motors and hard surfaces. They can damage ecosystems by harming fisheries, smothering native mussels and crayfish, and littering beaches with their sharp shells.

In the late 1980s, zebra mussels spread from Europe to the Great Lakes in contaminated ballast water discharged from foreign ships. From there, they expanded to the Mississippi River, its tributaries, and to inland lakes. Zebra mussels spread primarily by attaching to boat hulls, aquatic plants, nets, fishing equipment, or in water. Adult zebra mussels can survive out of water for days under certain conditions. Your actions are vital to prevent their spread.

General Characteristics

- Zebra mussels look like small clams with a yellowish or brownish "D"-shaped shell, usually with dark and light-colored stripes (hence the name "zebra")
- They can be up to two inches long, but most are under one inch. Zebra mussels usually grow in clusters containing numerous individuals and are generally found in shallow (6-30 feet), algae-rich water
- Zebra mussels are the only freshwater mollusc that can firmly attach itself to solid objects submerged rocks, dock pilings, boat hulls, water intake pipes, etc.
- On smooth surfaces, young zebra mussels feel like fine sandpaper.
- Juveniles are about the size of peppercorns.



What You Can Do

- Learn to recognize zebra mussels.
- **Inspect** and **remove** aquatic plants, animals, and mud from boat, motor, and trailer.
- **Drain** water from boat, motor, livewell, bilge, and bait containers.
- **Dispose** of unwanted live bait and worms in the trash.
- Rinse boat and equipment with high-pressure and/or hot water (104° F), especially if moored for over a day, **OR**
- Dry everything for at least 5 days.
- Never introduce fish, plants, crayfish, snails or clams from one body of water to another.
- Report new sightings note exact location; place specimens in a sealed plastic bag or store in rubbing (isopropyl) alcohol.

Know the rules!

The Indiana Association of United Ways, in partnership with the Indiana Bicentennial Commission, is coordinating the project in celebration of Indiana's 200th birthday.


The project will feature at least one fiberglass bison, the state symbol, in each of Indiana's 92 counties. The fiberglass bison stands 5' tall and is 8' long.





Lake Santee Regional Waste & Water District Meeting Minutes

Meeting of June 16, 2016 3:30 PM Lake Santee Community Room

1. Roll Call

Scott Gibbs called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Scott Gibbs, Jim Hornig, Paul Gosnell, Greg Montgomery, Frank Erdosy, Clair Fredrickson and Kathy Tarzwell. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator and Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from May 19, 2016
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Frank and seconded by Greg to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Operator's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon reported that the Sewer Plant is operating on a normal basis with no problems. All tests are in the normal range. Brandon ordered additional tanks and pumps as there are numerous new houses being built.
- b. Water Status Report Brandon reported that the Water Plant is operating well with all tests looking good with the exception of the HAA5 levels. One of the samples taken on May 17 showed a high HAA5 level again the other sample was just fine. Brandon will take samples from different areas of the lake and send them to two different labs to see if they get the same results. Dave from Water Solutions is assisting Brandon with this issue.
- c. Upcoming Conferences/Training Classes none this month.

4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad reported there were 14 credit card transactions, 142 ACHs, 1 valve turn and 2 shut offs; both are back on. Frank and Brad are looking into our phone service provider to see if we can get a better deal on this service.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments None this month.
- c. Correspondence Brad handed out a quote from Murphy Insurance for our liability insurance and is still waiting on one more quote to decide if we should stay with Murphy Insurance. Murphy will be conducting their annual insurance audit / walkthrough on 6/22 next week. We received approximately \$8,000.00 from Decatur County for payments on tax liens.
- d. Miscellaneous Agency Reporting None this month.
- 5. Attorney's Report Scott talked to Anne prior to the meeting. She indicated that the District does not need to do anything differently to keep Anne as our attorney as she transitions to a new firm. She also stated we do not have to send anything else to Evoqua at this time.

6. Committee Reports

a. Board Member Guide Committee – Board Training Topic – Greg gave a refresher course on the Leak Adjustment Program. As a result of this discussion, we will be making adjustments to the form that customers fill out if they request a billing adjustment. We will also be reviewing whether the policy needs any changes.

7. Old Business

- a. Napoleon Water No update this month.
- b. ACH program education Frank is still publishing information in the Smoke Signals on the ACH program to educate the customers about this time saving option. The LSPOA gave approval for us to set up a table for the July 4th festivities. Frank, Greg, Scott and Clair will man the table. There will be forms provided for anyone to sign up and a logoed cup give away.
- c. Internal Controls Standards Brad presented the Internal Control Standards Policy that he and Anne had been working on. Scott read Resolution 06-16-2016 as outlined by Anne. A motion was made by Clair and seconded by Kathy to adopt this Resolution. Motion passed. By next month, all the board members need to watch a video of the internal control standards which the State Board of Accounts requires us to watch. Discussion will be at the July meeting.
- d. Consumer Confidence Report Brandon finished the report and it is ready for mailing by July 1.

8. New Business

- a. Reserve Accounts Frank has been working with Brandon reviewing the maintenance recommendations from Dixon Engineering. They have also been reviewing the original budget reserve accounts and equipment life cycle estimates from the first rate study. Frank has generated some updated figures on how much we need to put aside for building and equipment when they need to be replaced. After some discussion it was decided that \$34,000 would immediately be set aside for the sewer account with \$150.00 a month thereafter. For the water account \$70,000 will be put aside immediately and \$2000.00 a month thereafter. Frank and Brad will look into the best option to invest this money until it is needed, but SBOA regulations will likely result in putting the money into CDs. A motion was made by Greg and seconded by Kathy to start this immediately. Motion passed.
- b. Ron Stryzinski of Lot 452 attended the meeting to ask if the District could provide water and sewer service to property adjacent to Lake Santee on County Road 880 E just west of his Lot 452. We will have to check with Anne to see if that is allowed, and if so, what the process would be to provide that service.

9. Adjourn

Signing up is easy – there are 2 ways. Go to the Lake Santee website (lake-santee.com), select Regional Waste & Water District, and then click on Governing Documents and Forms. Complete the Authorization Agreement for Direct Payments form and send the completed form to the RWWD Office.

OR, stop by the office and fill out the form there.

Recurring payments only need to be authorized once, prior to the first transaction. No further authorization is required to continue making payments to an account through the ACH.

Will I still receive a bill?

Yes, you will still receive a bill so you will know how much your Water/Sewer bill is each month. If you have any questions about your monthly bill, please contact the RWWD Office.






