On Sunday, July 17th, nineteen teams gathered at Lake Santee for the 6:00 AM takeoff of the fourth tournament of the 2016 season. With a front just having passed through less than 24 hours earlier, fishing was predictably tougher than it had been in the days leading up to the day's event. Lake Santee residents Chuck Sieg and Paul Bruns brought a five bass limit to the scales which weighed in a very respectable 15.58 pounds to take first place, ahead of Phil and Dustin Miller whose efforts resulted in a 13.36 lb. limit and allowed them to finish in a solid second place. Third place was captured by Jon Ohlmansiek and Rick Holt with four quality Lake Santee bass which totaled 11.64 lbs. Craig Duncan and Kyle Hohenburger only had one keeper bass for the day, but it was definitely the right size, as their fish took the Big Bass award with a 5.34 lunker. Congratulations to all our teams on a tougher than normal day at good old Lake Santee!

#### WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH




Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.

#### Zebra Mussel (Dreissena polymorpha)

Zebra mussels (*Dreissena polymorpha*) are prolific invaders that cost the U.S. billions of dollar each year. These small mussels from Eurasia can clog water intakes and damage equipment by attaching to boat motors and hard surfaces. They can damage ecosystems by harming fisheries, smothering native mussels and crayfish, and littering beaches with their sharp shells.

In the late 1980s, zebra mussels spread from Europe to the Great Lakes in contaminated ballast water discharged from foreign ships. From there, they expanded to the Mississippi River, its tributaries, and to inland lakes. Zebra mussels spread primarily by attaching to boat hulls, aquatic plants, nets, fishing equipment, or in water. Adult zebra mussels can survive out of water for days under certain conditions. Your actions are vital to prevent their spread.

#### **General Characteristics**

- Zebra mussels look like small clams with a yellowish or brownish "D"-shaped shell, usually with dark and light-colored stripes (hence the name "zebra")
- They can be up to two inches long, but most are under one inch. Zebra mussels usually grow in clusters containing numerous individuals and are generally found in shallow (6-30 feet), algae-rich water
- Zebra mussels are the only freshwater mollusc that can firmly attach itself to solid objects submerged rocks, dock pilings, boat hulls, water intake pipes, etc.
- On smooth surfaces, young zebra mussels feel like fine sandpaper.
- Juveniles are about the size of peppercorns.



#### What You Can Do

- Learn to recognize zebra mussels.
- **Inspect** and **remove** aquatic plants, animals, and mud from boat, motor, and trailer.
- **Drain** water from boat, motor, livewell, bilge, and bait containers.
- **Dispose** of unwanted live bait and worms in the trash.
- **Rinse** boat and equipment with high-pressure and/or hot water (104° F), especially if moored for over a day, **OR**
- **Dry** everything for at least 5 days.
- **Never** introduce fish, plants, crayfish, snails or clams from one body of water to another.
- **Report** new sightings note exact location; place specimens in a sealed plastic bag or store in rubbing (isopropyl) alcohol.

# September is prime time to enjoy the "flying flowers" that decorate late summer gardens.

#### A quick guide to identifying our common backyard butterflies

- 1) Monarch (To 4") Because of its endangered status, the Monarch Butterfly has received a lot of press and a nationwide movement to try to reverse its flight toward extinction. The orange wings with black veins are familiar to school children and adult fans alike. Eggs are laid on milkweed plants which are the sole source of food for the hatching caterpillars. The chrysalis is a beautiful green pendant with a thin gold band around the barrel. This popular butterfly has conservation groups working to preserve its wintering habitats in California and the mountains of central Mexico.
- 2) (Eastern) Tiger Swallowtail (To 6") Easily recognized for its distinctive yellow wings with black stripes, the Tiger Swallow tail is a common sight in our area this year with some relatively large adults being spotted. It is called swallowtail because the long "tails" on their hindwings are similar to the insect eating birds named swallows .The caterpillars feed on a variety of trees such as willows, cottonwoods, wild cherries and yellow poplars. The adults feed on flower nectar of native plants such as Joe Pye Weed, Purple Cone Flower and asters. Tiger Swallowtails enjoy a secure conservation status.
- 3) (Eastern) Black Swallowtail (To 3.5") Another swallowtail which is very common in our gardens is the Black Swallowtail. The mostly black wings are edged in double rows of yellow spots with an orange eye spot on the inside edge of the hindwing. Host plants for the caterpillars are parsley, dill, fennel and wild carrot also known as Queen Anne's Lace. Red clover, milkweed, and thistles are favorite sources of nectar for adults among many other flowering natives. Black Swallowtails also have secure conservation status.
- 4) Red Admiral (To 2.5") This smaller butterfly, so abundant last year, is making itself scarce this year. A red-orange bar across the black forewing gives it its name. There are white spots on the tips. The same red-orange borders the bottom edge of the hindwing. Caterpillars feed on plants of the nettle family. Adults prefer tree sap, fermenting fruit, and bird droppings but will visit common milkweed, red clover, asters and alfalfa flowers for nectar. Red admirals have secure status.
- 5) Great Spangled Fritillary (To 3") This butterfly lays eggs which hatch in the fall. Caterpillars overwinter and emerge in the spring to feed on violets. Mostly golden with black spots, adults take nectar from black-eyed Susans, thistles and other flowers. The zinnias at the Nature Habitat are attracting many Great Spangled Fritillaries.

President Veach called for a review of the minutes of the July 13, 2016 meeting. The minutes were approved on a motion by Mike, seconded by David.

Angel Hocker gave a brief review of the Treasurer's report. The Treasurer's report was approved subject to audit.

After presentation, the bills were approved for payment on a motion by Mike, seconded by Jim.

### MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS AND COMMENTS

The board was met with a full house of members and attenders. Members were asked to introduce themselves and were given the opportunity to express comments.

### Nature Habitat

Charm Seright, representative of Friends of Wildlife, explained that the Habitat Gardens are in place and are a beautiful place to go sit on a bench, watch black swallowtails (among many others), and enjoy nature to relax. Dick asked Charm to explain where the Habitat is located for members who may not know. Charm explained the location, and that the habitat is about 8.83 acres of scenic plants and animals. Charm also informed the residents that on Sept 7 at 6:30 pm, the Friends of Wildlife group will be hosting a presentation by Chris Fox called Butterflies and Dessert. [Not to be taken as Butterflies for Dessert- Dick =) ha, ha.] Chris will be presenting a power point on the Monarch Butterfly that evening in the Community Room.

### Sea Shack/Stacy House

Jennifer Koerting then explained that she has been a resident of Lake Santee for 8 years now and that she is attending the meeting as a show of support for Stacy House and the Sea Shack. Jennifer stated that in her time here at the lake she has watched many restaurants come and go and believes that most just cannot survive the winter months. She went on to explain that they chose the lake because of the phenomenal community and that Stacy House, being the first person she met here, was a contributing factor. Jennifer stated that she is passionate about supporting the Sea Shack, Stacy and the survival of the business and suggested that the board increase dues \$5 to give back to the business. Jennifer also presented a petition signed by numerous lake members and residents in support of the Sea Shack to remain open.

Scott Monteith then began speaking on behalf of the Sea Shack and Stacy House. Scott explained that he is a nine-year resident who comes from Indy. He and his family enjoy eating at the Sea Shack when they get here and believe that the restaurant provides the lake with a valuable service and amenity. Scott explained that whether people enjoy the type of food the Sea Shack offers, the service that is provided, or Stacy herself, the restaurant provides the lake with a valuable resource and amenity. Many other lakes do not have a beautiful restaurant on the beach that members and the community can enjoy. Scott stated he thinks the lake should raise dues \$10-20 for the benefit of the Sea Shack, give free rent and utilities etc. to ensure its survival. Scott believes Stacy is vested, committed, devoted, and passionate about the lake and the business.

Dick stated that the Board appreciates the comments of these supporters and members, and then took a moment to clarify some misconceptions. Dick began by stating that the Board also thinks that Stacy is a great person. Dick started by explaining that currently the LSPOA is under contract with the current proprietor. Dick stated he read on Facebook that the Lake Board needs to take a hands-off approach with the restaurant. Dick then explained that the Board does just that. He went on to say that on August 1, the contract with the proprietor of the Sea Shack came due. The Board had approved the renewal of the contract with this proprietor during the previous meeting. Sixteen days prior to the renewal, the proprietor decided that he was not going to chose to renew the contract with the Association due to lack of time he has to put into the business. At this time, the proprietor began talks with Stacy House about possibly turning over much of the business to her, and allowing her to make a go of things, with the possibility of taking over the contract with the Lake. The proprietor therefore asked for a ninety-day extension of the contract, which the Lake granted. The Board will then look at entering into a new contract with a new proprietor, whomever that may be. Dick also explained that all monies the Association takes in as rent on the business is put back into the business in the form of upkeep, updates, equipment, etc. as well as service on the building and the contents. The rent on the Sea Shack is by no means a moneymaker for the Association. The LSPOA charges a minimal fee as rent so that we can purchase items such as bar stools, furniture, and a new HVAC system. Dick then went on to explain that tonight in our old business portion the board needs to vote to extend the contract with the current proprietor for the 90 day period, through November 1. Dick validated that the winter months are tough on the business the restaurant receives. Dick spoke in great detail and hoped that he was able to clear up any misconceptions that are out there about the Board and the restaurant. The Board truly appreciates the thoughts and ideas presented by the members and acts in the best interest of the entire association.

### CORRESPONDENCE

Brad stated that he received two letters from members, Gordon and Susan Burgess as well as Pam Kachur, in support of the Sea Shack and its survival and asking that the Board work with Stacy to keep the restaurant open.

Dick also stated that the Lake's Attorney had received a letter from attorney, Chris Stephen, on behalf of the Stengers concerning the opening of the North Entrance. The letter is requesting information from the LSPOA and Dick wanted the record to show this.

### Recreation - Carol Goodwin

Dick took over for Carol in her absence. On the 13<sup>th</sup> there will be a scavenger hunt and lunch for kids as well as the Lake Santee Women's Club Auction beginning at 6:00pm. The 14<sup>th</sup> is the LSPOA Annual Meeting and election of officers, please join. The 20<sup>th</sup> will be the Golf Cart Run and the 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm the *Indiana Boys* will be performing in the amphitheater.

### **Lakes & Beaches – David Martin**

David stated that all of the green umbrellas have been successfully refurbished and the yellow is next. The Board was not happy with the netting in the bottom to control birds nesting and he is looking into a vinyl lining to complete this job.

David also discussed the dam face as well as dredging. David has received an estimate from Thomas Docks on both. The dredging would be done differently than in the past using bags that allow the water to drain out and then the ability to get rid of the dry sludge easily. The same company would be able to place new stone on the dam face from the water, keeping heavy trucks and equipment off of the dam itself. The company would also be available to complete dredging for private owners during this time. A member interjected his knowledge of this method of dredging and agreed that this is a better avenue for the Lake to go. David then made a motion to approve Thomas Docks as the vendor of choice for the 2017 dredging portion of this project. The motion was seconded by Ron, and the motion carried. ### Clean Up – Jim Massingale

Jim stated that the committee sent out four first letters, two third letters, four second letters, and four "Thank you" letters.

### Roads & Maintenance - Ron Day

Ron stated that the dust control has not been put down due to frequent rain and rain forecasts. Ron explained that due to the time of year, he is not sure if any will be used this season. He also informed Vinyl Solutions completed the railing around the deck of the Sea Shack finishing the job that the Booster Club had begun. Ron explained that a drain was installed across the entrance to the east beach bath house to handle run off.

Ron also stated that he is looking into the mailbox "cluster" issue and has a proposal. The clusters are a bit of an eye-sore. Ron has been in contact with the 16 owners that are part of a cluster close to him about a pilot project on these clusters. Ron would like to have maintenance supply material and labor to replace these boxes with all the same look, and consistent placement to try to create a uniform look. Ron asked for approval to complete this project that would cost less than \$100 for the association, and the member responsible for the box itself. The project was approved on a motion by Polly, and seconded by Angel.

### Security - Mike Cutrufelli

Mike began by thanking the security crew for all of their time and work. He also explained that the team has the security truck back and it has been fixed. The truck had a bad engine that has been replaced with a GM remanufactured engine with a 3 year 100,000 mile warranty. (The Board applauded Mike for his short report).

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Dick asked for a motion to approve the modification to the contract with the current proprietor of the Sea Shack for the extension through November 1. The motion by Ron and seconded by Mike carried.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Brad explained that he has received a bid for propane from Premier for 1.599. This is down from 1.749. This price includes numerous discounts and regardless of increase in costs, our price will never be higher than 1.599 but if the cost is lower we will get the lower price. Dick asked for a motion to approve going with Premier for the said price, motion made by Polly, seconded by Jim. Motion carried. The new price will begin now through May 31, 2017.

### **MANAGER'S REPORT**

Brad asked for approval to write-off delinquent fees only in the total amount of \$726.76 on settlements. The actual dues were paid and the Lake will only be writing-off delinquent fees charged. The motion by Polly, seconded by Jim carried.

Brad stated that the Association has sold three more lots and is down to only having six still for sale.

Brad received an email that the "Free Little Library" from the FFA and the Public Library is ready to go and will be installed close to the bicycle rack where it will be under the camera's supervision on Friday morning.

Brad is also still working on getting tax assessments brought down. The county had added all land around the beach area with the restaurant, which they have now separated. Brad has also appealed 10 other parcels of unusable land around the power lines.

Anthem sent a refund from July 2012 in the amount of \$120.45 but said the check was never cashed. Brad has submitted a claim to reissue this check.

There being no further business, Mike moved to adjourn, seconded by Ron, motion carried. The next regular meeting will be held on September 14, 2016 at 7:30 PM in the Community Room.





### Lake Santee Regional Waste & Water District Meeting Minutes

Meeting of July 21, 2016 3:30 PM Lake Santee Community Room

### 1. Roll Call

Scott Gibbs called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Scott Gibbs, Frank Erdosy, Clair Fredrickson and Kathy Tarzwell. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator, Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent, and Anne Poindexter, the District's attorney.

### 2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from June 16, 2016
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Kathy and seconded by Clair to accept the consent items with corrections to the Registers of Claims. Motion carried.

### 3. Operator's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon reported that the Sewer Plant is operating on a normal basis with no problems. All tests are in the normal range. Brandon stated that July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend went well. Pump calls are normal for this time of year.
- b. Water Status Report Brandon reported that the Water Plant is operating well with tests looking good with the exception of the HAA5 results. A Public Notice will be placed in the August Smoke Signals along with a Newsletter providing additional information about this issue. IDEM has been contacted to provide guidance on how to proceed. Also, Water Solutions brought in additional testing equipment which can provide immediate test results to help track down the root cause of this issue; samples taken have shown that the HAA5 levels are high leaving the plant. It has been recommended that the clear well (the finished water holding tank under the Water Plant) be inspected and, if needed, cleaned. Dixon Engineering will be contracted to perform this work. After that, more samples will be taken before and after each step to make sure all levels of HAA5 are in the normal range. IDEM has been helping us to get this matter resolved. While IDEM was here they did a yearly sanitary survey and everything is looking good.
- c. Upcoming Conferences/Training Classes none this month.

#### 4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad reported there were 20 credit card transactions, 143 ACHs, 1 valve turn and 7 shut offs. All are back on.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments None this month.
- c. Correspondence
  - i. Brad had Murphy Insurance re-bid our liability insurance to multiple companies. They did receive a quote lower than our current policy cost. Our current insurer, Cincinnati Insurance, has agreed to match the price of the lower quote. Cincinnati Insurance also recently conducted a site audit with no problems indicated.
  - ii. We received a tax lien refund from the County on lot 1608. We received this refund twice. Brad will work with the county to correct.
- d. Miscellaneous Agency Reporting None this month.
- 5. Attorney's Report None this month.

### 6. Committee Reports

a. Board Member Guide Committee – Board Training Topic – Frank has done some research on FDIC Insurance and our current bank accounts and will report below on his findings. So, Scott handed out some general information on FDIC insurance and how it works, what it covers, what it doesn't cover, etc.

#### 7. Old Business

- a. Napoleon Water Brandon reported that Gene (from Napoleon Water) is still working on the valving arrangement and cost estimates.
- b. ACH program education The District set up a table during the July 4<sup>th</sup> festivities to provide educational information on the ACH program. Frank is still putting info into the Smoke Signals on the ACH program to educate customers. Frank will get forms for sign up to put into the new member packets that the POA hands out.
- c. Internal Controls Standards Update A couple of typographical errors were noted and corrected in the current version of the Standard. Clair and Kathy were appointed to be the Oversight Committee as required by the Standard. Frank made a motion to accept the updated 7/19/16 version, Kathy seconded. Motion passed. All board members have viewed the Internal Controls training video.
- d. Reserve Accounts Update Frank has the new reserve accounts and the ongoing monthly transfers all set up. These transfers will be reviewed annually. He noted that the ditch witch and the gator will need to be replaced in a few years.
- e. Property west of Lot 452 Add to District Boundary We received the formal letter from the property owner asking for water and sewer service be provided to the property just west lot 452. This property is not currently included in the District's service area. It was decided that Brandon would generate the costs to install these 2 services to this property and then Brad will get with the property owner to discuss these costs. If the property owner would still like to pursue the District providing these services after he has learned of the initial installation costs, then the District will move forward with his request. We want to be sure the property owner understands the process and the initial costs to run service that far from our mains, because once the District acquires the property into our service area, the property owner will be required to hook up to the District services.

#### 8. New Business

- a. FDIC Insurance / Banking Options Frank recently met with Jason at Mainsource Bank to review the District's accounts, specifically related to FDIC Insurance coverage. Frank explained many aspects of the FDIC Insurance and how the District's accounts are setup. Jason confirmed to Frank that all of our accounts are covered and fully insured up to \$1.75MM. Frank also noted that recent changes to Chapter 15 from the State Board of Accounts have reduced the maximum term of Certificates of Deposits that Special Districts can invest in to 24 months.
- b. Differential Guidelines Prior to this year's Management Agreement with the POA, the District will be developing guidelines to help determine the differential payment amounts. The goal is to objectively and fairly evaluate the amounts paid. Scott asked the board members to be thinking about the guidelines that we want in place for discussion at next month's meeting. Frank will start an evaluation of the current practice, working with the Annual Salary Survey provided by the Indian Rural Water Association.

### 9. Adjourn


