The Lake Office will observe winter hours beginning October 1: Monday-Friday 9:00am-4:00pm, Closed Saturday & Sunday. Evenings & Saturdays by appointment.

The Trash/Recycle Center will observe winter hours beginning October 4: Tuesday & Thursday 3:00pm-5:30pm, Saturday 1:00pm-5:00pm & Sunday 1:00pm-5:00pm. Heavy Trash October 1 – 9 during normal hours.

Now is the time to start planning to get your boats out of the lake for winter. Lowering of the lake to winter levels will begin the second week of October. Winter level will be set between 3' & 5'9" below overflow elevation. The gate will be closed again by March 1, 2015.

Reminder: Political Signs may be displayed on the property owner's lot during the period between 30 days before (Oct 9th) & 5 days (Nov 13th) after the date of the election (Nov 8th), no more than 2 signs per lot & signs may not exceed 24"x36".

(The rumor after the tournament was that Rob caught all the keepers!) Not only did the pair take top honors for the day, this effort allowed them to clinch the USA Bassin' Lake Santee IN-47 Division Title. Don and Bonnie Mohr caught a very impressive 11.95 pounds which was anchored by Bonnie's 5.81 lunker, to capture second place. The son/father duo of Matt and Scott Perkins managed to bring in 11.21 lbs. to finish a strong third place... all with just three bass! Congratulations to all the teams!!! A special thanks goes to all the great folks at the <u>Greensburg Buy Right Automotive</u> for sponsoring this tournament's plaques. Thank you Jackie!

Speaking of the USA Bassin' Division IN-47 Champions, what a tight race that proved to be, with only TWO points separating the Top 3 teams! Great job to all our contenders and good luck to all our teams headed to the various regional events for that chance to move on to Kentucky Lake in May of 2017 and compete for new Ranger Boats and tens of thousands of dollars in cash and prizes!

As we were compiling the records for the 2016 Lake Santee regular season and the USA Bassin' IN-47 Division, it became evident just how competitive the tournaments are and what a great fishery Lake Santee has become. Here are some fun facts for everyone to consider!

- *The average keeper bass at Lake Santee weighs 2.8 pounds.
- *There were fourteen bass weighed in over 5 pounds, several topping 6 pounds!
- *Bass exceeding 4 pounds are becoming so common, many went unrecorded individually at weigh in.
- *Winning stringers averaged 3.6 pounds per bass.
- *The average winning stringer weighed over 18 pounds for five bass.
- *The largest stringer weighed in was 21.30 pounds for five bass.
- *The smallest stringer weighed in was 13.70 pounds, and that was just a THREE FISH LIMIT!

WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH



Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.

Zebra Mussel (Dreissena polymorpha)

Zebra mussels (*Dreissena polymorpha*) are prolific invaders that cost the U.S. billions of dollar each year. These small mussels from Eurasia can clog water intakes and damage equipment by attaching to boat motors and hard surfaces. They can damage ecosystems by harming fisheries, smothering native mussels and crayfish, and littering beaches with their sharp shells.

In the late 1980s, zebra mussels spread from Europe to the Great Lakes in contaminated ballast water discharged from foreign ships. From there, they expanded to the Mississippi River, its tributaries, and to inland lakes. Zebra mussels spread primarily by attaching to boat hulls, aquatic plants, nets, fishing equipment, or in water. Adult zebra mussels can survive out of water for days under certain conditions. Your actions are vital to prevent their spread.

General Characteristics

- Zebra mussels look like small clams with a yellowish or brownish "D"-shaped shell, usually with dark and light-colored stripes (hence the name "zebra")
- They can be up to two inches long, but most are under one inch. Zebra mussels usually grow in clusters containing numerous individuals and are generally found in shallow (6-30 feet), algae-rich water
- Zebra mussels are the only freshwater mollusc that can firmly attach itself to solid objects submerged rocks, dock pilings, boat hulls, water intake pipes, etc.
- On smooth surfaces, young zebra mussels feel like fine sandpaper.
- Juveniles are about the size of peppercorns.



What You Can Do

- Learn to recognize zebra mussels.
- **Inspect** and **remove** aquatic plants, animals, and mud from boat, motor, and trailer.
- **Drain** water from boat, motor, livewell, bilge, and bait containers.
- **Dispose** of unwanted live bait and worms in the trash.
- **Rinse** boat and equipment with high-pressure and/or hot water (104° F), especially if moored for over a day, **OR**
- Dry everything for at least 5 days.
- Never introduce fish, plants, crayfish, snails or clams from one body of water to another.
- Report new sightings note exact location; place specimens in a sealed plastic bag or store in rubbing (isopropyl) alcohol.

"Butterflies and Pie"

drew a crowd of friends to Chris Fox's presentation about the state of the endangered Monarch butterfly and how we can help them survive. Thanks to everyone who came and shared their enthusiasm as well as their enjoyment of an impressive variety of pies and desserts, ice cream, coffee and wildlife stories. Door prizes were won by Amy Bultman, Braydon Bultman, Jean Stutz, Sandy Dickey, Roberta Speer and Susan Burgess.

Thanks to Deb Evans we had a living demonstration of the developmental stages of the Monarch butterfly from egg to caterpillar to chrysalis to adult. Her hatched adult male gave Chris an opportunity to demonstrate how to tag a butterfly for scientific tracking purposes. He was released the next morning and hopefully is on his way to overwinter in Mexico. Vaya con Dios, Hermanito. (trans. Godspeed, Little Brother.)

Why Monarchs are Important

- 1) Monarchs are pollinators. "Butterflies are the third most populace pollinator behind bees/wasps and flies." (Southern Wild Design) Because the world's food supply depends upon pollinators the loss of any species is a great concern.
- 2) The Monarch butterfly is an indicator species that tells us about the health of our environment. These creatures are sensitive to changes in climate, the presence of harmful chemicals, pollution in the air and water, and other changes.
- 3) Monarchs achieve an extraordinary migration pattern that connects the three countries of North America. From their overwintering site in the mountains of central Mexico to as far north as the Great Lakes and Canada and back, "most monarchs joining the fall migration are three or four generations removed from those that made the journey the previous year." (Monarch Task Force of the North American Pollinator Protection Campaign) Students, scientists and citizens, children and adults alike work together to study and learn from each other and from cultural connections that benefit us all.
- 4) Monarchs are an important thread in the Web of Life. "Humankind has not woven the web of life. We are but one thread within it. Whatever we do to the web, we do to ourselves. All things are bound together. All things connect." Chief Seattle

How to Help

Milkweed is essential to the growth and development of Monarchs. There are over 100 native species, each one appropriate to specific areas. Dedicating a patch of your garden to a variety of species is an open invitation for Monarchs to breed. The adults need nectar plants to provide energy for breeding and migrating so include a variety of flowering native plants for color and continuous bloom. Avoid using herbicides and pesticides. Encourage the use of public lands for Monarch habitat such as parks and roadsides. (NAPPC) For example, the butterfly gardens at The Nature Habitat have proved a successful habitat for breeding Monarch butterflies. Since Monarchs in nature can suffer up to 90% mortality rate from wind, rain, cold, predators, mowing, and spraying, dedicated people collect eggs and caterpillars to hand-raise and release as adults. Responsible rearing can have up to a 90% success rate. 

President Day called for a review of the minutes of the August 10, 2016 meeting. The minutes were approved on a motion by Carol Goodwin, seconded by Mike Cutrufelli.

After presentation, the bills were approved for payment on a motion by Carol Goodwin, seconded by Steve Gauck.

MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS AND COMMENTS

Members were asked to introduce themselves and were given the opportunity to express comments.

Members brought up several topics:

Gina Fehrenbach and Dave Julien (118) – Gina and Dave had a couple of questions and concerns in regards to the beach area. They have recently spent some time down on the beach and noticed cigarette butts, broken glass from beer bottles, broken wire from fencing, and bird droppings on the fabric-covered benches. Gina asked what is/can be done to prevent this from happening. Dave Martin spoke up and said we are in the process of figuring out a way to enclose under the umbrellas to prevent the birds from nesting there. We also have the goose buster to attempt to keep the geese off the beach. Brad Jones mentioned the beach is scheduled to be raked on Monday's and Friday's by maintenance this is always weather permitting as some times the sand is too wet for this to be completed. Dave Julien asked about the enforcement of beach passes and who was responsible for patrolling the beach area. Brad explained if a beach guard is on duty they are responsible for checking passes, Lake Security and the office will occasionally walk down to check passes as well. Dave also brought up the issues of beer bottles on the beach and his concern for kids getting hurt by the broken glass. Brad clarified that bottles are not allowed on the beach and if the beach guards notice someone has them they are encouraged to call security.

Rick Johnson (543) – Next Thursday (September, 22nd) the annual meeting for the Clarksburg VFD will be held along with a chili supper. Dues were mailed out and are \$30 and can be paid at the meeting, Lake Santee Marina, or to any fireman.

Bob Honkomp (1351) – Bob mentioned that he was at the meeting in regards to a letter he wrote the board in regards to excessive noise and loud music coming from a few boats on the water. He is requesting a rule be created to enforce noise issues coming from the water. He has noticed a total of four boats that have speakers that are blasting out towards the skier/wake boarder. He is asking for the use of speakers to be prohibited. Bob also referenced rule 5.5 of the Lake Santee Rules and Regulations and wondered if his request could be included with this rule. He feels the super loud speakers could fall under the equipment used to perform special effects. He would appreciate the Boards consideration in reviewing the rules to determine if something can be added or created to prohibit the use of these types of speakers.

Angel discussed briefly the concerns we have received in regards to loud music coming from boats and that the Board would look further into this situation.

Recreation - Carol Goodwin

Carol was contacted by Jim and Julia Massingale (156) to request permission on the use of the amphitheater on Sunday, September 25th at 2:30pm for a performance by the Poling Brothers, a gospel singing group. The use of the amphitheater was approved on a motion by Carol Goodwin, seconded by Mike Cutrufelli. The last band scheduled for the season will be on Saturday, September 24th at 7:00pm Avocado Chic will be performing in the amphitheater. Trick or Treat and Trunk or Treat have been scheduled for Saturday, October 29th from 5:30-7:30. Please have your porch light on if you are wishing to have trick or treaters or feel free to bring your treats to the main parking lot to join in the fun.

Lake & Beaches – David Martin

David stated that he met with Scott Thomas of Thomas Docks to test the bags that will be used with the dredging. They filled 2-five gallon buckets with sludge from the north end of the lake and placed it in a sample bag. The water drains out of the bag leaving dry dirt that can be moved elsewhere. The sample bag will be opened to determine how much sledge was removed. Dave also mentioned that the plan is to still get the dam face completed in the spring.

Clean Up – Steve Gauck

NEW BUSINESS

He mentioned that two of these properties the lake currently has liens on. Ron asked for a motion to approve the possible purchase of the lots, motion made by Angel Hocker, seconded by Carol Goodwin.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Brad stated that the association sold one more lot and is now down to five lots for sale.

Brad is also still working on getting tax assessments brought down on some lake owned property around the power lines.



Lake Santee Regional Waste & Water District Meeting Minutes

Meeting of August 18, 2016 3:30 PM Lake Santee Community Room

1. Roll Call

Scott Gibbs called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Scott Gibbs, Frank Erdosy, Clair Fredrickson, Jim Horning, Greg Montgomery, Paul Gosnell and Kathy Tarzwell. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator, and Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from July 21, 2016.
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Frank and seconded by Kathy to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Operator's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon reported that the Sewer Plant is operating on a normal basis with no problems. All tests are in the normal range. Pump calls were up just a little. Brandon got in more tanks and pumps as there are more homes being built right now and a few more are scheduled for this fall.
- b. Water Status Report Brandon reported that the Water Plant is operating well. Dixon Engineering drained and cleaned the clear well on August 9th. They reported that the clear well was not too dirty and the baffles looked to be in good shape. They recommended we have the well inspected every 5 years. We continue to work with IDEM on the HAA5 issue. Turbidity readings are good. Brandon took more samples from two different areas of the lake and at the plant and sent them to the lab hopefully all this will take care of the HAA5 problem. We will get the results back in a couple of weeks. Brandon has made a change to the potassium permanganate, as well. One customer had a complaint of a smell in his water in his house. Brandon and Frank conducted tests and nothing was found wrong.
- c. Upcoming Conferences/Training Classes none this month.

4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad reported there were 19 credit card transactions, 141 ACHs, 0 valve turns, and 6 shut offs. All are back on.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments Lot 344 asked for an adjustment on his bill due to a water leak in his house. The leak has been fixed and all paperwork required was in good order. A motion was made by Jim to accept the adjustment of \$197.27 and seconded by Greq. Motion carried.
- c. Correspondence None this month.
- d. Miscellaneous Agency Reporting None this month.
- 5. Attorney's Report None this month.

6. Committee Reports

a. Board Member Guide Committee - No training this month.

7. Old Business

- a. Napoleon Water Brandon talked to Gene and he had some price estimates for us for the backup connection to Napoleon Water. To install our portion of the pipe, hook up to the new main and ½ the cost of pit will be around \$10,000. We could have some extra costs from attorney fees, flush valves, etc. The board was all in agreement to move forward with the project. Brandon will let Gene know.
- b. Property west of Lot 452 Add to District Boundary Brandon worked up the costs for the utilities hook ups and presented to the property owner. The property owner had not indicated whether he wants to move forward with this work. Brandon explained the costs for both water and sewer so everything is understood.
- c. Differential Guidelines A discussion of the guidelines that should be considered when determining the differential amounts was held. Frank will collect all this information, along with the historical data from the District to offer a couple of options at the next meeting.
- d. Internal Control Standards Clair had a question of whether the computers that were used for credit card payments were hard wired to the internet per Internal Control Standards. Brad confirmed that they are.

8. New Business

a. Board Member Appointment Renewals – Paul Gosnell is the only board member up for renewal in 2016.

Recurring payments only need to be authorized once, prior to the first transaction. No further authorization is required to continue making payments to an account through the ACH.
