Dear HOA and Property Owners,

It is with great pleasure that Thomas Docks, Inc. has been selected by the HOA board to perform the dredging work at Lake Santee. The estimated project time is 45-60 days depending on weather. We ask ALL boaters to remain clear of the dredging area. The process we will be performing is with a Hydraulic machine. We will be placing temporary block concrete anchors in the dredge area. The concrete anchors will be connected together with cables. This anchor system will allow the hydraulic dredger to pull itself in a straight line direction while dredging. It will also help in the increments moved per pass. The dredged material removed will be pumped into Geo-tubes which will be placed at selected lake access areas. Once the tube is at full capacity and the sediment turns into a solid the bag will be removed and the site restored.

WE ask ALL boaters to limit navigation in the dredging area to daylight hours only. The pipeline and machine will remain in the middle of the dredging area during the night. Failure to do so could result in damage to the engine lower units and/or engine props.

<u>During the process of dredging and the moving of material we ask that ONLY members of the board and/or authorized personnel access the staging areas. Under NO circumstances shall anyone not directly associated with Thomas Docks, Inc. or it's affiliate's access or board ANY equipment used by Thomas Docks. Inc.</u>

WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH




Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.


April and Spring are finally here, which means its time for some spring cleaning for all of us.

The R.W.W.D. will begin theirs this month by flushing the water mains. This will begin on Thursday April 6th. from 8:00 A.M. to about 3:30 P.M. This will be done on each of the 4 Thursday's in April the 6th.,13th.,20th and the 27th. with no interruption's in service.

In May we will begin checking and recalibrating all of the water meters that are in use now. We have purchased new testing equipment for this project. We are doing this to assure both you, our customers, and us that we are getting accurate readings. This will take an extended period of time for the maintenance crew to get to everyone. They will notify you when yours is being done. You will only have about a 20 to 30 minute interruption in service while they change your meter.

Our new leak detection program is working very well. [We now read your meter twice a month to give us an early warning of a possible leak]. This program is to help minimize damage to homes and help prevent excessive bills due to leaks.

The interconnect with the Napoleon Water Co. is continuing on schedule. This is being done to insure each district will have an emergency water source in case of a catastrophic failure by either utility.

1. Roll Call

Frank Erdosy called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Frank Erdosy, Scott Gibbs, Clair Fredrickson, Jim Hornig, Paul Gosnell and Kathy Tarzwell. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator, Brandon Litmer, and Utility Superintendent. Greg Montgomery was absent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from February 16,2017
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Clair Fredrickson and seconded by Kathy Tarzwell to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Superintendent's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon Litmer reported that the sewer plant is operating well with no issues. Jesse Baughman has agreed to take classes to get the license for sewer testing. He already has his license for Treatment and Distribution. Brandon Litmer is going to look for classes for Jesse Baughman to take to get this license.
- b. Water Status Report Brandon Litmer reported that the Water Plant is running on a normal basis. The meter tester and the new meters have been ordered. They are expected to be here shortly. Brandon Litmer has taken samples of the water for the quarterly tests we have to send in to IDEM. There were no issues with the changing of the new carbon. Everything is done and back online. The carbon was the same price as last time we purchased it. Napoleon is working on acquiring the easements needed for the hook up with them. They are also working on the design of the hook up in the pit for the connection. Brandon Litmer is going to check with the carbon company and the EPA to see if we can put the old carbon in the reservoir area the RWWD owns.

4. Administrator's Report

- Status Report Brad reported there were 18 credit card transactions, 157
 ACH's, 5 valve turns and 1 shut off, which is still off.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments None this month.
- c. Correspondence We have a credit from Frontier for \$10.09. Brad Jones is trying to get them to send us a check for the amount, instead of sending a statement with the amount stated. Our phone service is now with ETC. The rate change information has been entered into our billing program. A message will be on each billing statement about the increase, per our ordinance.

5. Attorney's Report - None this month.

6. Committee Reports

- a. Ordinances, Policies, Resolutions Clair Fredrickson has been going through the obsolete ordinances, policies and resolutions. He is trying to find an easy way to store those that are obsolete. He will ask Ann Poindexter if we can just keep paper copies of them as other options are more complicated.
- b. Public Relations It has been determined that we need to represent RWWD better to our customers. Paul Gosnell is going to put articles in the Smoke Signals talking about what RWWD does. He will also put up some flyers at the entrance to the lake with information about us.
- c. Signs Frank Erdosy asked Scott Gibbs to check on prices for signs to place at various areas for RWWD. After some discussion it was decided not to put out any signs at this time.

7. Old Business

a. Leak Detection Policy – The program has been going smoothly. There have been no issues. Only minor leakage usages were potentially detected.

8. New Business

a. Time of Lake Santee RWWD meeting - After much discussion it was decided that the time of our meetings will stay at 3:30 PM on the third Thursday of each month.

ACH transactions occur electronically and automatically, which dramatically reduces the number of individuals who have access to personal or financial information. Since ACH transactions are electronic they cannot be misplaced, lost in the mail or stolen.

SAFTEY IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME



Practice Your Escape Plan

Here are some fire safety tips to remember when you are practicing your plan.

Escape Plan Essentials:

- Always have at least two ways out of each room, such as doors and windows.
- Make sure that all exits are clear and working. If doors or windows are blocked by items such as boxes or furniture, someone, especially young children, may not be able to move them quickly enough to escape. Test your windows to make certain that they are not stuck shut and screens are removable from the inside. If your windows have bars on the outside, find out if they can be opened during an emergency and if not, have them retrofitted to be opened from inside.
- Teach children how to unlock and open the window in case they ever need to get out. If a screen is on the outside, demonstrate how they can remove it.
- Choose a meeting place where members of your family can assemble once you get out. This location should be safely accessible for all members. For example, if small children are in the family, choose a location where they would not have to cross the street, such as the mailbox, a tree in the yard, or the neighbor's fence.
- Practice your plan at least twice a year. Make sure that you have also practiced at night because some family members may not wake up to the smoke alarm and the exits are more difficult to find by feeling your way through the dark.
- Call your local fire department and notify them about any special circumstances within your home, such as two babies in one room, someone with a physical disability, or any person with special needs. This ensures the information is available to them before an emergency happens. Also share this information with your neighbors so they may inform the police and fire department in the event of an emergency.
- Once everyone gets out, make sure that they stay out!
- Know how to call 9-1-1 from outside to report the fire.

Spring Planting for Habitat – Native Plants are Best

By now the March lion and lamb thing should have sorted itself out and April will be amenable to planting trees and shrubs for habitat. While filling feeders throughout the winter to support wildlife is necessary, the best plan is to Create, Protect and Restore habitat with native plants. Not only are natives hardier and easier to care for, they attract and nourish a greater variety of birds, bees and butterflies.

An often overlooked small native tree for spring bloom, summer berries and fall color is the Common Serviceberry*. It is as beautiful as the invasive Bradford Pear and will not smother other plants. Other shrubs that thrive in our area are Spicebush for the Spicebush Swallowtail butterfly, several dogwoods* for flowers and seeds, Virginia Sweetspire* for flowers and fall color. A brilliant red berry for winter feeding is produced by Common Winterberry* as well as for spring bloom and fall color. Larger native trees that provide shelter, nesting sites and insects are Eastern Red Cedar, White Pine*, Oaks* and Redbud*.

The earliest native blooms for bees are the often-despised but highly valuable dandelions! Other spring bloomers* are false indigo, geum, pachysandra, phlox, wild pinks.

Late May is seed planting time for fall plants that provide nectar and seeds for food such as sunflowers and cosmos. Common Milkweed and Butterfly Weed provide crucial host plants for Monarch butterflies and can be planted as seeds or nursery plants. Other popular host plants for butterflies are parsley, dill and fennel.

Summer blooms* for nectar and/or seed are coreopsis, coneflower, coralbells, false sunflower, geranium, sundrops, obedient plant, and Jacob's ladder*, along with monarda (bee balm), wild columbine, and foxglove.

Common late summer blooms* are sneezeweed, pink turtlehead, Joe Pye weed, hibiscus, liatris (blazing star), asters and Goldenrod. These are especially important for migratory birds and butterflies that need nourishment for their long journey to their winter habitats. Leave the coneflower, cosmos and asters standing for winter seed feeding and self seeding in the spring.

*These plants are available at Jackson's Nursery where there will be free milkweed pods for your Monarch garden in the fall. Monarch Butterfly Pollinator Habitat

Mark May 20th on your calendar as a day to help plant the new garden from 9:00 am to noon at the recycle center. Roughly 2 acres will be ready to receive about 600 plugs of native plants and help is needed to get them into the ground and off to a good start. Bring your shovel or trowel and join in the fun! Lunch and beverages will be provided.

While your calendar is available don't forget to add the Spring Wildflower Walk April 16th from 2:00 – 4:00 pm. The skunk cabbage will be long past bloom but with the late spring there will be so many little discoveries yet to find. Guides and refreshments will be provided.



limitations, in response to a claim for which the insurer is liable under the policy. Requires notice to the claimant when a fire department is reimbursed under a policy.

Ron wanted to add that if you know anyone over the age of 18 and interested in becoming a member of the Clarksburg Volunteer Fire Department they are in need of volunteers.

Brad asked for the board to approve a write-off for \$833 that he believes is now uncollectable, as the property (lot 1039) has gone through Sherriff Sale. A motion was made by Mike Cutrufelli and seconded by Polly Ann Fox. Motion carried.
