

SAFTEY IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME



Child Safety

Children are vulnerable to burns and injury. Below are some simple tips to help reduce the risk of harm:

- Use tamper-resistant electrical receptacles inside the home.
- Keep children up to 3 feet away from the stove, open fires/flames, and heaters.
- Keep matches and lighters in a locked cabinet.
- Be sure to test bath water; a bath should be warm to the touch, not hot.
- Remember, children's skin is more sensitive and burns easily.
- Never hold a child in your arms while preparing hot food or drinking a hot beverage.
- Make sure children know how to escape the house in the event of a fire. Teach children how to call for help and practice your escape plan.

Burn Hazards Around the Home

There are countless safety hazards around the home. Below are suggestions of how to keep your family safe:

- Never leave a portable heater unattended and be sure to keep all flammable objects at least 3 feet away.
- If you have a fireplace, make sure your chimney is inspected and cleaned each year. Also, use a fireplace screen to prevent sparks from igniting objects outside the fireplace.
- Keep all light fixtures and bulbs away from flammable objects.
- Only use extension cords as a temporary measure. A qualified electrician should install additional circuits when necessary.
- Check electrical cords throughout your home and replace them if they are frayed or show signs of wear.
- Remove potential fuel sources from your yard such as tree branches and trash.

WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH




Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.



For the folks that caught fish- shallow, moving baits seem to be the most productive methods, be it crankbaits or spinnerbaits. The team of Rob Merriman and T.J. Edwards took top honors as they culled up to 20.54 lbs. The team of Jon Ohlmansiek and Rick Holt kept it interesting with another five bass limit totaling 16.10 lbs. Jon shared with us he caught three of their fish on back to back to back casts at the start of the event... Wow! Marco shared with us that the giant bass bit a jig & trailer under a dock with just minutes left in the day! In addition, there were three bass over five pounds and more four pound bass than we could count brought to the scales!! Congratulations everyone, well done!!

Our winners and Big Bass champs each took home beautiful plaques which were provided by this month's sponsor, Mary Hamer at Klosterkemper Tax Service in Greensburg IN. On a related note, many times Lake Santee members ask, "What can we do to help make the lake healthier?". One of Nature's most beneficial vegetations are reeds or "cattails" as they are locally referred to. Years ago, Lake Santee was ringed with long rows of cattails and, as longtime members can recall, the lake teemed with life. Today, our cattails have been cut and removed to the point that only a few patches remain. Before you go out this spring and decide to cut down any of the cattails which may grow along the lake's edge, take time to consider all the advantages these plants provide. Soil erosion control, wildlife habitat, picturesque views, and an investment in clean water that we all need...







Also in attendance was Brad Jones, Utility Administrator. Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent, was on vacation.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from March 16,2017
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Jim Hornig and seconded by Clair Fredrickson to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Treasurer's Report

Greg Montgomery reported we have two CD'S maturing and he is getting quotes from various banks to see which one has the best interest rate.

The interest from the two maturing CD'S will be deposited into the general fund.

4. Superintendent's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Since Brandon Litmer was on vacation, Frank Erdosy gave the sewer report. IDEM conducted a compliance inspection on February 23. They did find a few differences which are being addressed. We have to develop a Preventative Maintenance plan and start a PM log. We have to modify some of our testing sheets. The changes will be made to the sheets as advised by IDEM. We also have to make some small changes on some of our testing procedures. We have 30 days to respond to IDEM in writing that all of the differences have been corrected to their specifications.

The new carbon is working as expected. Every Thursday in April we will be flushing the water mains. Flushing will start around 8 AM and stop around 3:30 PM.

- a. Status Report Brad Jones reported there were 18 credit card transactions, 160 ACH's, 2 valve turns and 6 shut offs, with 3 still off.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments None this month.
- c. Correspondence None this month.
- 6. Attorney's Report Ann Poindexter is here this month to inform us about the lawsuit and the procedures for conducting the executive meeting.

7. Committee Reports

- a. Public Relations Paul Gosnell will put a newsletter in the Smoke Signals letting members know what is going on with our projects.
- b. Old Carbon Jim Hornig questioned why the 18 bags of carbon are still at the maintenance area. Brandon Litmer still has not gotten an answer from the EPA to see if we can distribute it at the old water plant site. We have to find out if it is toxic before we can do anything with it.

ACH transactions occur electronically and automatically, which dramatically reduces the number of individuals who have access to personal or financial information. Since ACH transactions are electronic they cannot be misplaced, lost in the mail or stolen.

How do I sign-up?

Signing up is easy — there are 2 ways. Go to the Lake Santee website (lake-santee.com), select Regional Waste & Water District, and then click on Governing Documents and Forms. Complete the Authorization Agreement for Direct Payments form and send the completed form to the RWWD Office.

OR, stop by the office and fill out the form there.

Recurring payments only need to be authorized once, prior to the first transaction. No further authorization is required to continue making payments to an account through the ACH.

Will I still receive a bill?

Yes, you will still receive a bill so you will know how much your Water/Sewer bill is each month. If you have any questions about your monthly bill, please contact the RWWD Office.



Spring in all its Beauty at The Nature Habitat

Wildflowers in yellow, purple, pink, white and maroon, along with ferns, fungi and a couple of critters rewarded the wildflower walkers on a lovely Easter Sunday afternoon at The Nature Habitat. Fourteen plants in bloom and buds and foliage on 12 more promise a long-lasting spring and summer of enjoyment. Even the weather cooperated providing us with a break between rain showers! A very special discovery was the Eastern Box Turtle. They are becoming increasingly rare due to habitat loss and road death so it's good to know that The Nature Habitat is providing food, water and shelter for this one. Thanks to Deb Evans, Kathy Winzenread, Betty Gabbard and Dallas Whipple for guiding and donations. Thanks to Carol Goodwin, Paul Gosnell and Brad Jones for the publicity. Thanks to Betty Gabbard and Chick Winzenread for the replacement bluebird nesting box. It's already inhabited!

Hummingbird Alert!

It's time!! As of today (April 18, 2017) there hasn't been a report of a Hummingbird scout returning to Lake Santee but they are coming so be prepared! Remember that your feeders should be kept clean and nectar should NOT contain red food color (no matter what the manufacturer claims.) A red colored feeder will attract them. To prepare your own nectar "add ¼ cup white table sugar to one cup of boiled water. Allow the nectar solution to cool before filling your feeder." (Wild Birds Unlimited) Refrigerate leftovers until needed. Hummingbirds like trumpet vine, coralbells, jewel weed, cardinal flower, honeysuckle, and monarda (bee balm) for natural nectar. They also consume tiny insects and spiders so avoid using toxic garden chemicals. Hummingbirds love water misters and will dart back and forth to bathe or take a drink and then perch on a branch or twig. Happy Hummingbirding!

Chinese mystery snail

At our April meeting Dallas Whipple introduced us to the Chinese mystery snail found here at Lake Santee. "Though native to East Asia from the tropics of Indochina to northern China, this species has established itself in North America." It likes fresh water lakes with soft, muddy or silty bottoms so it's no surprise it likes living here. According to Wikipedia it has become "a problematic invasive species" in many areas. It is popular with aquarium keepers because it cleans the algae off the glass sides. They have served as a food source and were sold in the San

Francisco markets in the 1940's. I guess what a person eats depends upon how hungry he/she is and what's available!

On May 4th we'll be taking a road trip to Brookville to pick up plants for the Habitat gardens. If you'd like to join us, email charm.seright@gmail.com. On May 20th, 9:00-noon we'll be helping to plant plugs at the Monarch/Butterfly/Pollinator Garden at the recycle center. Beverages and lunch will be served to volunteers. Join us!



Terri said she would get with the club and get back with him.

Dick Veach (1384) – Dick wanted to thank the Clean-up committee for taking action on an item he brought up at the last board meeting in regards to dumpsters being needed at a home where a remodel was being completed and a new construction.

Paul Gosnell (1147) – Paul stated that he spoke with Annette Geis from Vinyl Solutions and the material has been delivered. They hope to start the work on April 17th weather permitting. Paul also provided a photo of the six picnic tables that will be donated from the Lake Santee Booster Club to LSPOA for use on the deck at the restaurant.

CORRESPONDENCE

Brad stated the insurance audit has been completed and that he has received the report but is waiting on the agent to call with the actual results. Recreation – Carol Goodwin

Carol asked for volunteers to help fill Easter eggs in the Community Room on Friday at 4pm. She mentioned the Easter bunny would be making an appearance on Saturday at 11am. A big thank you to everyone who donated, candy, money, and time helping.

Carol announced the start of the Euchre Club and will be starting in May. The lake still has three corn hole sets available for purchase. The price will be \$75.00 to purchase a set (boards & bags) please contact Carol.

Lakes & Beaches – David Martin

Dave stated that three loads of sand were brought into the beach and they are working on grading and raking the beach. The vinyl sample for under the umbrellas has been dropped off and Brandon and Thomas Docks are working together to determine the best way for it to be utilized under the umbrellas at the beach.

Aquatic Control has recommended that we stock the fish at the same level as last year. The order has been placed and is the same price as last year. We will be purchasing 4,000 large mouth bass and 1,400 hybrid stripers.

Dredging has started at the north end of the lake and is estimated at taking 30 days to complete. They are taking 6ft passes and going over the area three times. There was a small hiccup at the beginning where a bag rolled onto four of our docks on lake access 544. The straps holding the bag in place snapped causing the bag to roll. Thomas Docks will replace the docks damaged. If you were renting/using a slip in this area please contact the office if you need a place to dock your boat while dredging is being completed. Dave asked to keep boats out of the dredging area for safety concerns.

Clean Up – Steve Gauck

Roads & Maintenance – Polly Fox

Polly stated that maintenance has begun filling the potholes on the gravel roads and that New Point Stone will begin spreading new stone soon. The rejuvenation will also start soon and will begin on Santee Drive near lot 1190 and will finish up at the north end of the lake. The summer maintenance help will start in May.
