SAFTEY IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME



Outdoor Burning

- Check with your local fire department or municipality for any restrictions before starting an open-air, recreational, or outdoor cooking fire. Obtain proper permits, if required.
- You might not be permitted to do outdoor burning in some municipalities and during some seasons.
- Closely supervise all outdoor fires. Make sure the fire is out before leaving.
- Supervise children around any fire outdoors, including campfires, fire pits, chimineas, and outdoor fireplaces.
- Permitted open fires, such as bonfires or trash fires, need to be at least 50 feet (15 meters) from anything that can burn.
- Permitted recreational fires such as campfires, need to be at least 25 feet (8 meters) away from anything that can burn.
- Avoid burning on windy, dry days. When conditions are windy or dry, it is easy for open burning to spread out of control.
- Where outdoor burning is allowed, never use gasoline or other flammable or combustible liquids.
- When burning, have a hose, bucket of water, or shovel and dirt or sand nearby to extinguish the fire.

If You Are on Fire

- If your clothes catch fire, stop, drop, and roll. Stop, drop to the ground and cover your face with your hands. Roll over and over or back and forth until the fire is out.
- If you cannot stop, drop, and roll, keep a blanket or towel nearby to help you or others smother flames. Cover the person with a blanket to smother the fire.
- If you use a wheelchair, scooter, or other device and are able to get to the floor, lock the device first to stay in place before getting on the floor to roll until the flames are out.
- Immediately remove loose clothing or clothing with elastic bands, belts, and jewelry.
- Treat a burn right away by putting it in cool water for 3 to 5minutes. Cover with a clean, dry cloth. Do not apply creams, ointments, sprays, or other home remedies.
- Get medical help right away by calling 9-1-1 or the fire department.





- You can drop off batteries and printer cartridges at the Greensburg Public Library (inside first set of doors) during their normal business hours.



WANTED BULLHEAD CATFISH




Lake Santee is experiencing an unwanted increase in its number of bullhead catfish. Unlike Channel Catfish, Bullheads are an undesirable fish whose size remains small, and can quickly overpopulate. Bullheads are bottom feeders that stir up bottom sediments, which can increase turbidity, and add to our water clarity issues. Channel Catfish can be easily distinguished from Bullheads by their deeply forked tail. Anglers, please remove all Bullhead Catfish that you catch. Thank you, Lake and Beaches Committee.







1. Roll Call

Frank Erdosy called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Frank Erdosy, Scott Gibbs, Clair Fredrickson, Jim Hornig, Paul Gosnell, Kathy Tarzwell, and Greg Montgomery. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator, Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent and Scott Wyatt, attorney for the district.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from March 16, 2017
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Clair Fredrickson and seconded by Kathy Tarzwell to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Treasurer's Report

Greg Montgomery got quotes from several area banks for cd's and went with Main Source Bank for 18 months with a no penalty letter for early surrender.

4. Superintendent's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon Litmer stated he ordered 12 more pumps to replace some we used and to get ready for several more homes that are going to be built in the near future. He also stated that the forms IDEM wanted updated have been completed along with the preventative maintenance plan.
- b. Water Status Report Brandon Litmer reported that the flushing of the water mains is about halfway completed. The flushing is going well with no problems. We need to do some metals testing on the old carbon to make sure it is safe to dispose. A lab In Columbus will do the testing. With a proper result test it will be put in a landfill.

5. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad Jones reported there were 20 credit card transactions, 169 ACH's, 3 valve turns and 4 shut offs, with 1 still off.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments None this month.
- c. Correspondence Brad Jones filled out paperwork to show our tax exempt status to Premier Ag Co-Op and mailed it back to them. He also finished a U. S. census bureau of public employee payroll report. He discussed that we need to setup equipment set aside accounts for both the water and sewer plants.
- d. Attorney's Report nothing this month.

6. Old Business

- a. Leak Detection Policy The policy lapses next month so it was determined that we need this policy only during the colder months. We will bring it back from December thru March. Scott Wyatt will work up a policy for this.
- b. Jesse Sewer license Brandon Litmer is looking for classes for Jesse to take.

R.W.W.D. minutes continued

- c. Internal Control Policy Oversight Committee Kathy Tarzwell reported that all the policies are working ok with no problems.
- d. Napoleon Auxiliary Water Supply Gene Eaton from Napoleon is waiting on 2 easements to be signed so the project can continue.
- e. Lawsuit "525" The attorney for LSPOA has asked for an extension so he can gather more information.

7. New Business

- a. Security of Water and Sewer Plants It has been decided to update our security at both the water and sewer plants. We are looking into cameras and door alarms. Brandon Litmer is getting quotes for this from ETC, ADT and one other company.
- b. Water Tower Exterior Overcoat Brandon Litmer will look thru the Dixon Engineering recommendations for the overcoating. He says the overcoating will run approximately \$40,000. Scott Wyatt is checking Indiana law for procedures and requirements on whether to use quotes or the public bidding process.
- c. Water Tower Foundation Repair and Security Brandon Litmer stated that some small repairs are needed on the foundation. They will be approximately \$2000.00. He is also going to look into security possibilities for the Water Tower.

8. Trustee Reports

a. Clair Fredrickson has gone through the outdated resolutions and they will be archived. He is looking into the policies now to see which ones can also be archived.

9. Adjourn

Recurring payments only need to be authorized once, prior to the first transaction. No further authorization is required to continue making payments to an account through the ACH.

May's Bird Migration Showed Movers on the Wing

Bird migration patterns are one of the specialties of the Cornell Lab of Ornithology and as the Lab tracks changes globally, we see changes in the patterns every spring here at Lake Santee. This year the Rose-breasted Grosbeak has thrilled birders with flocks of 8-10 or more at local feeders. The male is an unmistakable bird with its black back and wings, white belly and bright red triangle on the breast. The females and non breeding males are brown with two white wing bars. The Grosbeak part of the name comes from its large ivory bill. The RBG migration begins in Mexico, Central and South America and completes to nesting sites in northern Indiana and throughout Canada. The male arrives first in late spring followed by the females several days later. Its habitat is deciduous woods, orchards, groves and thickets. They leave early in the fall for the long trip south.

While Rose-breasted Grosbeaks have been in abundance, hummingbird devotees were anxiously awaiting the Ruby Throated Hummingbirds that visit flower gardens and nectar feeders. This amazing, tiny little bird is the only one that can fly backwards! Their migration is complete from southern states and also Mexico and Central America. The hummers are here but seem to be reduced in numbers. Remember, nectar for feeders can be made at home with a 1 to 4 ratio of sugar to water. No red dye is necessary and can be harmful so keep it clear!

If you see a bright flash of orange and hear a rich whistling song, run to the kitchen and get some grape jelly and orange halves to add to the nectar feeders. Striking black and orange male Baltimore Orioles and pale yellow females have been visiting around the lake. Their preferred habitats are open deciduous woods but they have been known to do well in community parks and backyard habitats that have tall trees. They nest from southern states to southern Canada and migrate to Mexico and Central and South America. Cornell Lab of Ornithology has been developing technologies to help answer the question "How can a bird navigate a 2,500 mile journey between North and South America?" It's an especially important question these days as bird migrations face weather challenges, habitat loss and urban lighting pollution as they work their way from winter habitats to their nesting sites.

The Nature Habitat

This is the second spring for the Butterfly Garden at The Nature Habitat. Both beds show a good return of last year's plants, especially Showy Sunflower, Black-eyed Susan and Purple Cone Flower. There are some new milkweed sprouts as well as Marsh Milkweed, Cardinal Flower, Blue Mist Flower, and Ohio Spiderwort plants added this spring. New England Asters and Butterfly Weed don't seem to have fared very well. Two new beds are being developed for additional pollinator plants and seeds. Thanks to Chick and Kathy Winzenread for the installation of the water barrels and donation of a bench. June is a great time to visit the Habitat to see emerging blooms and butterfly activity. The Monarch/Butterfly/Pollinator Garden being planted on Saturday, May 20th will be a great addition to wildlife habitat at Lake Santee!





MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS AND COMMENTS

Members were asked to introduce themselves and were given the opportunity to express comments.

Rick asked permission for the Fire Department to park the old Fire Engine in the gravel area at the fire station the week of the breakfast with a sign to remind members of the breakfast. A motion was made by Steve Gauck to allow and was seconded by Angel Hocker. Motion carried.

Bill Ryle (579) – Bill stated he was there on behalf of his daughter who owns 657 Sarsi Drive. He stated there were some drainage issues on the building site and he had contacted Brandon to look at addressing it. Brad stated he had discuss with Brandon.

Ronda Peetz (941) – Ronda shared with the audience a new mural that was recently completed in Greensburg on the Watson Chiropractic building located at the corner of Broadway and North St. She shared with the audience a picture of the mural that has Lake Santee's totem pole incorporated in the right wing. The mural was completed by Kelsey Montague and funded by a community fundraiser with Main Street Greensburg and others. She encouraged everyone to check it out.

Shirley Livesay (530) – Shirley wanted to thank Mike Cutrufelli for closing a neighbor's garage door after they noticed it had been open for some time.

Charles Winzenread (1097) – Charles stated he was concerned with the amount of money being spent on dredging and that he is more concerned with the roads not being paved or maintained.

Joe Jarman (92) and Greg White (859) – Both thanked the Board for the great job they do.

Nancy Fredrickson (348) – Nancy stated she noticed in the April edition of the Smoke Signals that the security report stated we weren't having gate guards. She asked when this was decided. Polly Ann Fox explained that the Board came to the decision during budget discussions and determined it would be best to have gate guards on holiday weekends and have a larger presence at the beach throughout the summer. By having attendants at the beach more frequently we will enforce the beach rules to help prevent trash on the beach area as well as ensuring non-members aren't using the beach.

CORRESPONDENCE

Brad presented a pamphlet that he had received in the mail for a conference on Dam Information Resources and Training. He asked the Board for approval to allow Brandon and himself to attend the conference. The cost is \$50 per person and is one day. There are a larger variety of sessions they will be able to attend for information on dams including but not limited to Dam's 101 – Basic Info, Funds for Dam's, Awareness of Dam's, and a Q&A session. The Lake Santee POA received an invoice via the attorney that the insurance company hired in regards to the current litigation at the north entrance. The bill is for \$2,500, which is the deductible on the Blue Chip policy of our insurance. This helps cover defense costs, damages, and obligations to pay. A motion was made by Dave Martin to pay the bill and was seconded by Steve Gauck. Motion carried.

Brad stated there was a tree struck by lighting on association owned property – Tract 1C. The association will need to have the tree removed as to prevent any future damage. We received two quotes to cut down and remove debris from tree leaving the wood to be used at the maintenance building – Hughes Tree Service \$900 and One Pride Tree \$500. Polly Ann Fox made a motion to use One Pride Tree subject to proof of insurance and good standing with the state; Angel Hocker seconded motion. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Rules & Regulations - Angel Hocker

Angel presented a first reading of rule 4.1 as the Board felt this rule needed updated to reflect how boats are currently titled. A member asked about the pros/cons of making adjustments to this rule. The board felt with the changes in boats it is hard to get a new

ski or speedboat in our current rule based on how the length of the swim platforms is now being included with the overall length of the boat on the title.

Current Rule 4.1

Only one boat of each type available is allowed on the Lake per membership. For example only one speed, pontoon, sail, bass and motorized fishing boat will be permitted. A deck boat may be substituted for either a speed or pontoon boat. In addition the member may have a canoe, rowboat, paddle boat, raft, etc. The length of speed, bass & fishing boats shall not exceed 20 feet. Deck boats are not to exceed 22.5 feet. Pontoon boats are not to exceed 28 feet. No watercraft with sleeping or on board toilet facilities will be permitted.

a) Paddle Boards will be considered a watercraft and will comply with all boating rules included in this boating section. Members may have up to six paddle boards in addition to the boats and watercraft listed above. Paddle boards will only require a single set of lot numbers and will only display one permit.

Proposed change to Rule 4.1

Rule 4.1 – Only one boat of each type available is allowed on the Lake per membership. For example only one speed, pontoon, sail, bass and motorized fishing boat will be permitted. A deck boat may be substituted for either a speed or pontoon boat. In addition the member may have a canoe, rowboat, paddle boat, raft, etc. The length of speed or deck boat, bass, and fishing boats shall not exceed titled length of 22 ½ feet. Pontoon boats are not to exceed 28 feet. No watercraft with sleeping or on board toilet facilities will be permitted.

a) Paddle Boards will be considered a watercraft and will comply with all boating rules included in this boating section. Members may have up to six paddle boards in addition to the boats and watercraft listed above. Paddle boards will only require a single set of lot numbers and will only display one permit.

A motion was made by Polly Ann Fox to change rule 4.1 as read; Steve Gauck seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The second reading will take place at the next board meeting on Wednesday, June 14th at 7:30PM.

A member in the audience asked if the board had considered creating a rule to keep members from filling the ballast on wakesetter boats as it creates havoc on the shore protection. There is a concern as we are seeing a large number of these types of boats being launched on the lake. The member stated some lakes are creating a rule stating that the ballast cannot be filled and if you are caught with it full there would be a fine. Angel stated the Board would take a look at these types of boats and determine if a rule needs to be made.
