



Water Tubing Tips: Boat Safety Tips for Water Sports Tubing

The next time you or your family decide to go out boat tubing, keep these boating safety and water sports tubing tips in mind to make sure your experience is safe and enjoyable:

1. Always wear a PFD

While it's always a good idea to wear a PFD (personal flotation device) when onboard, it should go without saying that you should wear a life jacket when water tubing. This is especially important in the event that the rider should become separated from the boat.

2. Know your equipment

Be familiar with the capabilities of your water sports tubing equipment. It's important to follow to the manufacturer's recommendations for water tubing capacity in terms of size and weight, number of riders, age limits, and maximum towing speed.

3. Know your rider

It's also important to use common sense when it comes to the capability of your rider, especially when water sports tubing with small children. While sharp turns, high speeds, and big waves can be fun, these should never come at the expense of rider safety.

4. Use a spotter

Designate one person onboard as a "spotter", who can not only keep a lookout for water tubing accidents or to see if anyone has fallen off the tube, but can also help keep the boat driver informed at all times.

5. Be aware of water regulations

Make sure you are familiar with the specific regulations governing the body of water you're boat tubing on, in particular towing speeds.

6. **Drive Responsibly**

The driver should be alert, sober, and have a solid grasp of boating rules and regulations. Be respectful of and keep your distance from other boats in the area when water tubing, and always keep an eye out for additional water hazards such as rocks, docks, and buoys.

7. Use a secure tow line

Another important safety aspect of water tubing, it's important to always make sure that the tow line is securely tied before take off. Also be sure to check for signs of wear, tear, and fraying, and replace as needed. Be sure to only use rope that is specifically designated for towing inflatables.

8. Check before you start

Never start the boat without first making sure that your rider is ready to go. This means that they have a firm grip on the line, are properly positioned on the tube, and that the line is properly and safely positioned. When water tubing with multiple passengers, riders should understand how to balance their weight correctly and work together to safely stay on the tube.

9. Handle wakes with care

Slow the boat speed when crossing wakes. Bouncing off wakes at extremely high speeds has been known to cause back injury, especially with riders who are water tubing stomach-down.

Exercise caution when pulling more than one tube

It's especially important to travel at slower speeds and keep an extra careful eye out if you are boat tubing with more than one tube. Dual water sports tubing can often result in large crashes and serious accidents, should the tubes happen to collide.

To all boating members:

RE: FINE POLICY – automatic \$75 fine for boating violations first offense, \$100 fine for 2nd offense, and a Board Review for the 3rd offense.

Lake Santee is a private lake for use by members of the Association. To restrict access and maintain a safe lake, Rules & Regulations must be in place and enforced for the benefit of the members. Due to the noticeable increase in reoccurring violations by members and guests, it is apparent that verbal and written warnings are not making an adequate impression on those violating the Rules & Regulations. A decision has been made by the Board of Directors to provide for automatic monetary fines for any violation of the following Rules & Regulations:

- 4.2 All boats shall have affixed the property Owners' lot numerals, in a contrasting color, not less than three (3) inches in height. Lot numbers shall be placed in the middle of the boat on each side thereof, clearly visible to the Lake Patrol at all times.
- 4.3 All watercraft must have a current permit affixed on the port (left) and starboard (right) side of the boat near the lot number or on the left and right side windows prior to launching. Annually, upon payment of dues, assessments and fees, members shall be entitled to purchase registered boat permits, which authorize them access to Lake Santee. Permits will be available in five different classes depending on the type of boat. The Board of Directors shall determine from time to time the amount of fee to be charged for such permits.
- 4.7 From sunset to sunrise no person shall operate a watercraft without displaying lights as follows:
 - a) Motorboats and auxiliary sail boats must display a white 360 degree aft light, or a combination aft and masthead light, at all times while under power or sail.
 - b) Motorboats and auxiliary sail boats with engine rated 15 hp or greater must display red and green bow lights when under power or sail,
 - c) Boats with engines less than 15 hp or using only trolling motors must display hand lantern or flashlight (visible for two miles) or white aft light in sufficient time to avoid a collision with any other boat.
 - d) All boats when not underway are required to display a white light visible in all directions whenever they are moored or anchored away from the dock between sunset and sunrise.
- 4.8 The following restrictions shall apply to motorboats while under power. No person shall:
 - a) Sit on gunnels (sides) or railings of a boat
 - b) Dangle feet from boat
 - c) Ride forward of the safety railing on pontoon boats
 - Stand, sit on seat backs or move about while pulling skiers, tubers, etc.
 - e) Ride on the upper deck of a pontoon.
- 4.11 No person shall operate a power craft upon Lake Santee during daylight hours at a greater speed than is reasonable, having due regard for traffic, surface and other hazardous conditions, with no power craft to exceed the speed of 35 miles per hour. Except that on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays the speed shall not exceed 30 miles per hour. No person shall operate a power craft upon Lake Santee from dusk to sunrise at a speed greater than idle speed. The period from dusk to sunrise shall be determined by observing the red signal light located at the south end of the Lake. The yellow signal provides a warning period during which you should begin to terminate high-speed operation, skiing and related activities.
- 4.12 No person shall operate a power craft within or through the shore zone or any cove at a speed greater than 5 miles per hour or a speed that creates a wake. The shore zone means that water area of a uniform width of 100 feet lying parallel and contiguous to the shoreline. The dam shall be considered a shoreline.
- 5.1 Water skiing shall be permitted on Lake Santee from sunrise to dusk, except in the posted fishing area, beach areas and coves. The period from sunrise to dusk shall be determined by observing the green signal light located at the south end of the Lake. The yellow signal provides a warning period prior to a red signal, during which skiing and related activities shall begin to be terminated.
- 5.2 There shall never, at any time, be more than two individuals pulled by any power craft.
- 5.3 No skiing, tubing or other similar water sport activity will be permitted without two (2) occupants in the boat, one for spotter. Spotters will be eight (8) years of age or older.
- 5.4 Any skier, tuber or anyone engaging in a similar water sport must have on his person a US Coast Guard approved type I, II or III personal flotation device.

A violation of any one of the above Rules & Regulations by a member or guest will result in the member being fined \$75, \$100 for 2nd offense & a Board Review of a 3rd offense.

SAFETY SIGNALS

Please take a few minutes to read this to keep everyone safe.

- Please follow all rules when on lake property.
- > All motorized equipment needs to have proper stickers, this includes autos, watercraft and golf carts.
- > Remember to have the correct safety equipment on all watercraft when enjoying the lake.
- Reminder, a water violation is an automatic fine.
- > Speed limit is 25 mph. If a contractor you fire is cited, you as the resident member will be responsible for their fine. Take a minute to inform your contractors accordingly.
- ➤ No glass containers allowed on the beach or area adjacent to the beach. RULE 6.5
- ➤ Cigarette smokers, no one wants to see your butt. The beach is not your ash tray, police your butts please. Continued abuse could result in a no smoking policy on the beach.
- No dogs are permitted in the designated beach areas. RULE 6.6
- Please be patient and remember the security personnel are here to assist and protect.







Charcoal Grills

- Use one of the following methods to start charcoal for cooking:
 - If you use a charcoal chimney to start charcoal for cooking, use a long match to avoid burning your fingers when lighting the paper.
 - If you use an electrical charcoal starter, be sure to use a grounded extension cord.
 - If you choose to use lighter fluid, use only fluid intended for charcoal grills.
- Never add charcoal starter fluid to coals or kindling that has already been ignited.
- Never use gasoline or any other flammable liquid except charcoal starter or lighter fluid to start a charcoal fire.
- Store the charcoal starter fluid out of reach of children and away from heat sources.
- Dispose of charcoal coals only after they are cool. Empty the coals into a metal container with a tight-fitting lid that is used only to collect coals.
- Place the container outside away from anything that can burn. Never empty coals directly into a trash can.

Propane Grills

- Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year and after each time the gas tank is reconnected. A soap and water solution (1/3 liquid dish soap and 2/3 water) applied to the hose and connection will quickly reveal escaping propane by causing bubbles to form. If you determine by smell or by the soap bubble test that your gas tank hose and connection has a gas leak, do the
- following:
 - Turn off the gas tank and grill.
 - If the leak stops, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again.
 - If the leak does not stop, call the fire department.
- Use only equipment that is listed by a qualified testing laboratory. Follow the manufacturer's instructions on how to set up the grill and maintain it.
- Always store propane gas tanks outside of buildings or garages. Vapors leaked indoors can be easily ignited by pilot lights or electrical equipment, causing an explosion. If you store a gas grill inside during the winter, disconnect the tank or cylinder and leave it outside
- Light a propane grill only with the cover open. If the flame on the propane grill goes out, turn the grill and gas off and wait at least 5 minutes before re-lighting.



On Sunday, August 17th, fifteen teams took part in the fifth event of the 2017 Lake Santee Bass Tournament season. As always, a very large group gathered to watch the weigh in and witnessed a rare but exciting twist. The winning team of Chris Roberts and Adam Engleking brought four bass to the scales totaling 11.87 pounds, but the best part was their bag was anchored by a 3.72 lb SMALLMOUTH BASS! What a great fish and testament to the diverse fishery that is our Lake Santee. Sheldon Roberts and Joe Ford finished in second place with three bass for 8.76 lbs., while Don and Bonnie Mohr continued their winning ways, capturing third with a 8.32 lb. sack of bass which included the event's big bass, a 4.08 trophy! Great job everyone!

Also occurring at this event, Lake Santee members Paul Bruns and Chuck Sieg captured the 2017 USA Bassin' division championship. USA Bassin' is a national bass fishing organization with thousands of anglers participating from over thirty states. With their accomplishment, Chuck and Paul have automatically qualified to participate in the Lucas Oil Tournament of Champions, an entry free tournament at Kentucky Lake in 2018 where they will compete for the \$10,000 first place cash prize. All that for just catching bass at Lake Santee!

Our anglers continue to participate in the "Tournament Restock Program" and the 2017 funds continue to grow. As most are aware, a small fee is collected at each tournament during the season, which is in turn used to purchase between 100-200 adult largemouth bass every fall from Eric at Clear Creek Fisheries in Martinsville, IN. These bass are then transported directly to Lake Santee, where they are released to grow to trophy size! All this is done voluntarily and is a way for the fishermen to give something back. In a time when many ask, "What's in it for me?", our anglers are stepping up and paying it forward. Voluntarily giving back, if you will... So please ask yourself, "What can I do to make our Lake Santee community even better?".

Speaking of making our community better, special thanks goes out to Mr. Jim Ponsler, candidate for Decatur County Sheriff, for sponsoring this month's beautiful trophies. Jim is a fine man and would undoubtedly make a great sheriff if elected!

Lake Santee Regional Waste & Water District Meeting Minutes

Meeting of July 20, 2017 3:30 PM Lake Santee Community Room

1. Roll Call

President Frank Erdosy called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Frank Erdosy, Clair Fredrickson, Paul Gosnell, and Kathy Tarzwell for a quorum. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator and Scott Wyatt, Attorney for the district. Absent Scott Gibbs, Jim Hornig, Greg Montgomery and Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes from June 15, 2017.
- b. Financial Reports
- c. Register of Claims for sewer operating
- d. Register of Claims for water operating

A motion was made by Kathy Tarzwell and seconded by Clair Fredrickson to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Superintendent's Report – Letter, on vacation

- a. Sewer Status Report Everything is going good at the sewer plant.
- b. Water Status Report In June we had higher than normal levels of manganese in our finished water that was causing some discolored water in the distribution system. This was caused by a spike in the raw water manganese levels that was high enough that the membranes were not able to remove all of the manganese. The discoloration was a result of the manganese coming into contact with chlorine in the clear well. The problem has been corrected and the distribution system has been flushed. We are monitoring the manganese levels very closely to avoid this happening again.
- c. Note: Brandon Litmer is obtaining quotes for a monitor that would provide real time manganese levels in the raw finished water so this type of problem can be further avoided.

4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad Jones reported there were 20 credit card transactions, 167 ACH's, 1 valve turns and 3 shut offs, with 1 still off. Brad Jones reported that we have 583 accounts as of July 20, 2017.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments There are 2 write offs this month. Lot 354 for \$857.62 and lot 1039 for \$484.61. A motion was made by Clair Fredrickson to write off both of these amounts and was seconded by Kathy Tarzwell. Motion carried.
- c. Correspondence Brad Jones filled out an audit from Cincinnati Insurance and sent it back.
- 5. Attorney's Report None this month.

6. Old Business

- a. Napoleon Interconnect Napoleon is waiting for a right-of-way.
- b. Water and Sewer Plant Security The camera and alarms have been installed. The

cameras are working well and are very clear. Better than we expected.

- c. Water Tower Exterior Epoxy Overcoat & Modifications Frank Erdosy signed the contract for the process to begin for the work on the tower. It will be high pressure cleaned on the outside with 3 coats of epoxy applied. A multitude of safety and upgrade work to follow on the inside of the tower.
 - d. Water Tower Security Put on hold until Brandon Litmer returns from vacation.
- e. Outdated Policies Clair Fredrickson has gone thru the policies and is now tackling the resolutions. Scott Wyatt, the district attorney is going to look at some of them and talk to Clair afterwards.
- f. Jesse Sewer License In August Jesse will attend an exam review course in North Vernon that is being offered by Alliance of Indiana Rural Water. We will purchase some textbooks for this course.
- g. State and Federal Grants Brad Jones stated that so far he has not found anything that would be beneficial to us.
- h. Oversight Committee Kathy Tarzwell reported that everything is going ok in the office and nothing has to be tweaked.

7. New Business

- a. Indiana State Police Frank Erdosy talked with Jim Ponsler @ Versailles Post and he stated that they will make diagrams of our facilities and they will be put into the computers in the cars assigned to this area. Information about both plants will also be included.
- b. Title swap with LSPOA Backhoe for Tractor All trustees need to go look at both pieces of equipment so we all know what we are talking about. Scott Wyatt explained that because we are a government entity we need to publish a notice of "intent to exchange". Further discussion will take place at the next meeting when all trustees are present.
- c. Phone number It was discussed that we need to publish again the phone number for water and pump calls. It is 812-560-1157. Brad Jones is going to make sure it is on our website and let customers know to call this number instead of security.
- d. Quorum Policy Kathy Tarzwell read the policy aloud. A motion was made we accept the policy by Paul Gosnell and was seconded by Clair Fredrickson. Motion carried.
- e. Replacement for Gator 4 person Vehicle Scott Gibbs will get with Brandon Litmer to find out exactly what equipment is needed in a vehicle of this type.
- f. The President asked Paul Gosnell and he has agreed to serve as an "at large member" on the executive committee. The board must vote to ratify his appointment.

MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS AND COMMENTS

Members were asked to introduce themselves and were given the opportunity to express comments.

Many members in the audience spoke on a variety of topics to include the following:

- On behalf of Friends with Wildlife Charm wanted to invite everyone to their September 6th meeting at 6PM to celebrate the 1st year of the butterfly garden. A meal will be served to include ham & beans, cornbread, and a variety of desserts (including pie). Everyone is welcome.
- Rule 13.15 stating that contractor signs are to be a minimum of 25' from roadways. It was mentioned that there was numerous signs in violation and had been for some time and asked for Security to take a look at these and move them to the appropriate distance. It was also noted that over the July 4th holiday weekend there was numerous trail blazer signs for garage sales.
- A member wanted to thank whomever has been picking up trash along the road.
- A member thanked Carol for the great recreation activities.
- It was also mentioned that after numerous complaints and emails the fabric chairs under some of the umbrellas have been removed from the beach. The member had stated there is numerous health concerns related to bird droppings.
- A member asked for a monthly budget to be placed in with the minutes. Another
 member mentioned many years ago the quarterly budget was published in the
 Smoke Signals. The member also stated a concern with a camper being parked
 in a driveway for a lengthy time, along with some trees overhanging Santee Dr
 near Chippewa Trail.
- A member was concerned with noticing multiple boating violations on the water at any given time. It was also mentioned that there is a concern for safety with boats pulling tubers across wakes of skiers or other boats.
- Mark Gordon stated his home had been broke into by forced entry sometime around July 18th. He thanked Security for their assistance until the Sheriff's Department arrived. He is very concerned that no alert was sent out to members via Facebook or email. It was brought up that the camera at the main entrance was not functioning around the time the break in is thought to have occurred. He was also disappointed that management had not notified all of the board members of the break in.

It was suggested we look at rules from other lakes to determine if there are any we could add, adjust our current rules, or even have a test members take before getting boat stickers.






