

Deadline for 2018 Dues and Assessments is April 1st

Statements for the 2018 Dues and Assessments will be mailed out on February 15th, are due March 1st, and past due after April 1st. The amount for 2018 will be \$660.00 (\$25 Dues and \$635 Assessment) and \$66.00 for each additional lot. This is a \$30 increase in Assessments, the first since 2016. Payment must be received in the office before April 2nd to avoid a 10% penalty. A monthly finance charge of 1 ½ % is charged on all outstanding balances.

Boat slips, boat permits and golf carts/UTVs will be the same as last year:

Boat slips \$275.00

Boats with a motor \$60.00 / Boats without a motor \$20.00

Paddle Boards \$15.00 maximum of 6 Golf Carts and UTVs \$35 and night operation requires an inspection.

A Lake Santee Boating Exam will be included with your statement and must be answered and returned with your request for boat stickers.

If you mail in your payments, permits and passes will be returned by mail except for the night operation golf cart/UTV permits.

If there is a fire, you may have less than 3 minutes to get out of your home. Talk about what you should do to be safe. Make sure everyone in your home knows what to do if there is a fire.



Put a check in front of each statement that is true for your home.

Smoke Alarms

- Smoke alarms are on every level of the home.
- Smoke alarms are inside and outside sleeping areas.
- Smoke alarms are tested each month.
- Smoke alarm batteries are changed as needed.
- Smoke alarms are less than 10 years old.



Test your alarm regularly.

Your smoke alarm is working if it makes a noise when you press the "test" button.

Cooking Safety

- The cooking area has no items that can burn.
- People stay in the kitchen when they are frying, grilling, boiling, or broiling food.
- Pot handles are always turned toward the back of the stove.

Escape Plan

- \square There is a fire escape plan that shows 2 ways out of every room.
- Everyone knows where the safe meeting place is outside the home.
- Everyone living in the house practices the escape plan 2 times a year.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- Carbon monoxide alarms are located on each level of the home.
- ☐ Carbon monoxide alarms are less than 7 years old.

Electrical and Appliance Safety

- ☐ All electrical cords are in good condition and not broken or cut.
- People clean the dryer of lint after every use.
- All plug outlets are safe and do not feel warm when you touch them. (If they are warm, call the landlord or an electrician.)

Candle Safety

- ☐ Candles are in sturdy fire-proof containers that won't be tipped over.
- Adults blow out all candles when leaving the room or going to bed.
- Candles are kept out of reach from children and pets.



Children are sometimes curious about fire.

If you have children in your home, lock up any items that can start a fire (matches, lighters, cigarettes, etc.) and make sure children cannot reach candles.

1. Call to Order / Roll Call

President Frank Erdosy called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Frank Erdosy, Clair Fredrickson, Scott Gibbs, Kathy Tarzwell, Jim Hornig, and Greg Montgomery. Absent was Paul Gosnell. Also in attendance were Brad Jones, Utility Administrator, and Brandon Litmer, Utility Superintendent.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes of November 16, 2017 Meeting
- b. Financial Report
- c. Register of Claims Water
- d. Register of Claims Sewer

A motion was made by Kathy and seconded by Clair to accept the consent items. Motion carried.

3. Superintendent's Report

- a. Sewer Status Report Brandon reported that everything is operating well at the sewer plant and all tests are normal. The cold temperatures have not become an issue, yet.
- b. Water Status Report The water plant is operating on a normal basis with no problems and all tests in the normal range. The test results of the quarterly DBP samples have been received and look very good. The HAA5 came back in the low 30s and the THHM in the mid-40s, both well within the required limits and keeping the 4 quarter averages well below the required limits. The existing granular activated carbon should be good until April. Brandon will take the next round of quarterly test samples in mid-February.

4. Administrator's Report

- a. Status Report Brad reported there were 24 credit card transactions, 176 ACHs, 9 valve turns, and 8 shut offs with all back on. A tax settlement check for 9 different liens was received from Decatur County.
- b. Write-Offs / Adjustments none this month
- c. Miscellaneous
 - i. Cincinnati Insurance performed an on-site audit and has issued us a partial refund on our premium based on how well/safe the premises are kept.
 - ii. The required public notices for next year's meetings have been published.
 - iii. Brad submitted the annual Federal Government Agencies form.
 - iv. Currently, the District charges a customer a flat \$3.00 fee to allow the customer to pay their bill utilizing a credit card. The credit card companies are charging the District 2.8% plus additional fees depending on the credit card company. Brad has done some analysis and recommends increasing the credit card fee charged to customers. Frank will discuss with Anne (the District's attorney) to review the process related to this change.
 - v. JUS software support contract is up for renewal for 2018. Renewal of the contract is being tabled until the issue related to the customer billing errors (see 7c below) that occurred for approximately 17 customers is resolved.

6. Old Business

- a. Outdated Ordinances Clair will continue to work with Anne on cleaning up the outdated Ordinances. Anne plans to be at the January meeting with a report.
- b. Jesse sewer license test IDEM has approved Jesse's application to take the test. The test will be scheduled for January.
- c. Napoleon Water cross connect Gene from Napoleon Water is awaiting the easement paperwork from the last land owner. Brandon has also been unable to contact that land owner in person to help move this process along. Frank will have Anne contact Napoleon Water.
- d. Insurance Bond for office staff Brad reported that no further information has been received from SBOA on whether individual bonds are required for the office staff or if the current cumulative bond that District maintains is sufficient.
- e. Tower security Brandon will begin the installation of the security measures that were previously approved...once the ground dries out or freezes to prevent ruts.
- f. Management Agreement with POA Frank distributed the completed Management Agreement to the Board and explained the differences in the costs from last year's Agreement, including raises for the employees and the differential amounts. After several discussions about the various line item costs in the Agreement, a motion was made by Jim and seconded by Clair to approve the 2018 Management Agreement as presented. Motion carried.

7. New Business

- a. Bonds Payment Account Kathy reported that payments to our bond holder will now be drafted directly out of our Money Market account.
- b. Put reminder in Smoke Signals about Rate Ordinance 10-15-2015 complete, this will be included in the January Smoke Signals.
- c. Customer billing errors The software (Jayhawk) that is used to read the water meters and create the customer invoices has been miscalculating water usage for approximately 17 specific customers. The software was reading only 6 digits on the meter and should have been reading 7 digits, thus underreporting the actual water usage. The software has been corrected and is now functioning properly. Anne will attend next month's meeting to discuss the next step.
- d. Ron Day Lake Treatment POA President Ron Day sent to a letter to the District asking to discuss the possibility of sharing the costs related to the lake treatment / algae control. These costs are not considered in the current customer rate structure, but could be considered in a future rate study. Frank tabled the topic for this meeting and this will be discussed in more detail in the future. Ron also mentioned that he is starting to work with IDEM/COE on erosion control measures for the banks of the creek feeding the lake, which abuts some District property.
- e. List of Customers owing funds Name, Address, Amount, Reason Frank asked Brad to prepare a list of customers who have outstanding balances with the District and bring to the January meeting.

Notice of rate increase on Water and Sewer bills

ORDINANCE NO. 10-15-2015

An Ordinance establishing a new District wide schedule of monthly user rates and charges to be collected from the owners of property served by the Sewage Works as well as the Water Works of the District, and matters connected therewith, amending in relevant part, Ordinance 4-21-2010:

WHEREAS, based upon the District's 2015 consolidated rate study, it is advisable to update the schedule of rates and charges for both the Sewage Works and Water Works of the District previously established under Ordinance 4-21-2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to change the schedule of monthly user charges for users of the District's Sewer and Water Works and adopt an increasing schedule of charges providing for such increases to phase in over the years 2016, 2017 and 2018.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKE SANTEE REGIONAL WASTE AND WATER DISTRICT:

Section 1. The schedule of monthly "Required Wastewater Rates and Charges" set forth on Exhibit A-1 and A-2, attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall supersede and replace the prior sewage works rates and charges set forth in Ordinance No. 04-21-2010.

Section 2. The "Required Water Rates and Charges" set forth on Exhibit A-3 attached hereto and incorporated herein shall supersede and replace the prior water user rates and charges set forth in Ordinance No. 04-21-2010.

Section 3. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any part of this Ordinance which can be given affect without such invalid part or parts.



Eagle Watch at Lake Santee

While there are Eagle Watch programs at state parks and recreation areas around the state, it is far easier to get an eyeful right here at Lake Santee. Just get out your binoculars and head to the Lake Santee Marina to get a good view from the boat ramp (dress warmly), or perch at a table at The Dockside Bar and Grill (view in comfort.) Don't have binoculars? Borrow the ones at The Dockside provided by Friends of Wildlife for your viewing pleasure.

Here are a few Bald Eagle facts to inform your watching:

Bald Eagles were seriously endangered in the 1970s but when DDT was banned they began a gradual comeback. The eagle nest near Lake Santee was documented in 2009 by the DNR, likely an offspring of the eagle population at Brookville Reservoir. There are now 300 nesting areas in Indiana.

Adults are marked by white heads and tails and a large yellow beak and legs. Perching birds measure 28-37" and have a wing spread of 6.5-7'. The female is larger than the male.

Juvenile eagles are dark brown with white spots or speckles over the body and wings. Juveniles take 5 years to achieve adulthood and the white head and tail markings.

Eagles are raptors and primarily live on fish. They will steal fish from Ospreys. They also hunt small prey and will eat carrion.

There is no such thing as a screaming eagle. They make a "weak, harsh chattering" noise and that's it.

Love is in the air in February when Bald Eagles begin their mating season. Their midair mating ritual, called cartwheeling, involves the male and female locking talons and tumbling until they break apart. Now that would be something to see!*

MANAGER'S REPORT

Brad stated that postage is going up \$0.01 as of January 21st. The Lake Office uses a metered machine, which saves \$0.03. A bad debt expense of \$837.05 was collected. We were able to redeem \$100 off the credit card that will be credited to our next bill.

President Day took a brief minute to state as of today (January 10, 2018) he was submitting his letter of resignation as President and Board Member. He wanted to thank everyone for the opportunity to serve on the Board and represent the LSPOA membership for the past 3 ½ years.

There being no further business, Carol Goodwin moved to adjourn, seconded by Polly Ann Fox, motion carried. The next regular meeting will be held on February 14, 2018 at 7:30 PM in the Community Room.
