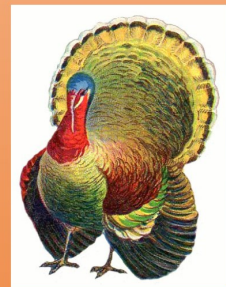

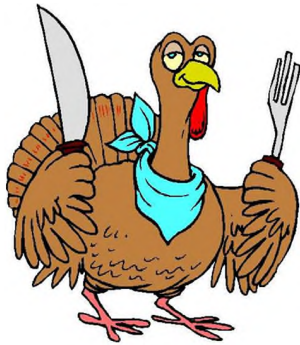

CREAM OF POTATO SOUP

PREP: 30 MINS | **TOTAL TIME:** 45 MINS
SERVINGS: 8 BOWLS

8 medium potatoes peeled and quartered	1 teaspoon garlic powder
3 stalks of celery chopped	1 teaspoon parsley
1 medium onion chopped	2 cups heavy cream
1 stick of butter	5 slices American cheese
1 ½ teaspoons salt	Salt and pepper to taste
1 ½ teaspoons sugar	Milk

STEP 1 In medium stock pot combine all the above ingredients and barely cover with water. Bring to a boil then simmer until potatoes are tender and water has reduced by half. Remove from stove and using a potato masher, mash until desired consistency. A few lumps are fine.

STEP 2 Return pot to low and heat and add following ingredients: 2 cups heavy cream, 5 slices American cheese and salt and pepper to taste. Add milk to desired consistency. This is a local favorite recipe—enjoy!

BASS TOURNAMENT SEASON FINALE

SEPTEMBER 30th. 2018

The 2018 Lake Santee Bass Tournament season came to a close on September 30th with a beautiful day to be on the water. The fishing had predictably become tougher as the late-summer doldrums had the bass somewhat lethargic, but, as always, someone always manages to catch the big ones at Lake Santee. For the third time this year, the father and son team of Butch and Marco Mikesell brought in the winner stringer with five bass weighing 14.94 pounds. Their sack also included the event's big fish, a 5.12 lb. beautiful, largemouth bass. Second place was taken by the Miller brothers, as Phil and Dustin weighed in four bass which totaled 12.64 lbs. Rob Merriman (again fishing alone!) brought two bass to the scales which weighed 6.80 pounds to hold on to third place. Congratulations to all of our anglers!

As everyone knows, our last tournament of the season is dubbed the "End of Summer Event". For the last few years, Mr. Paul Pank of the Hilliard Lyons financial consultant office in Greensburg, IN has graciously sponsored a meal for all of our fishermen and important friends following the tournament. This year's meal was prepared by the Waldron Restaurant and was fantastic as always! Many thanks to Paul and all the great folks at the Waldron Diner for your support. Should anyone be seeking the expert advice of a wealth advisor or a wonderful meal, we could not suggest two finer businesses!

Thanks also go out to Shannon Gibbs of the Lake Santee Property Owners Association Board for providing the plaques at this year's End of Summer Event.

Now would also be a great time to thank our fishermen for their contributions towards the supplemental restocking program our tournament series initiated several years ago. To date, several hundred largemouth bass have been purchased through donations of our tournament anglers at each event, which were then stocked into the watershed. With the tremendous generosity of our angling teams, we will be able to continue with this program again for the fall of 2018. Because of our competitors' willingness to "pay it forward", hundreds more largemouth bass will be purchased in the coming weeks and be transported to their new Lake Santee forever home! We would like to take a moment and publicly thank all of our awards sponsors, the Lake Santee Property Owners Association Board, Paul Gosnell and Nancy Fredrickson with the Smoke Signal, Mike Cutrufelli and the Security Team, and the general public who attend our weigh-ins for the support we receive. 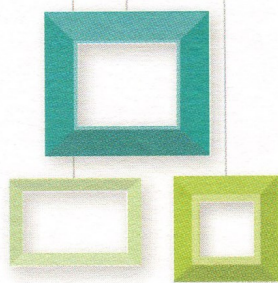

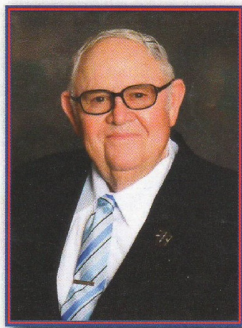

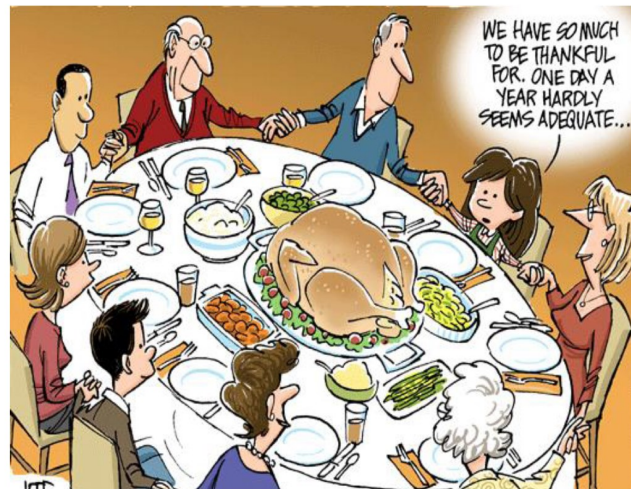

GREENSBURG— The Greensburg Optimist Club recognized their Firefighter of the Year Thursday morning.

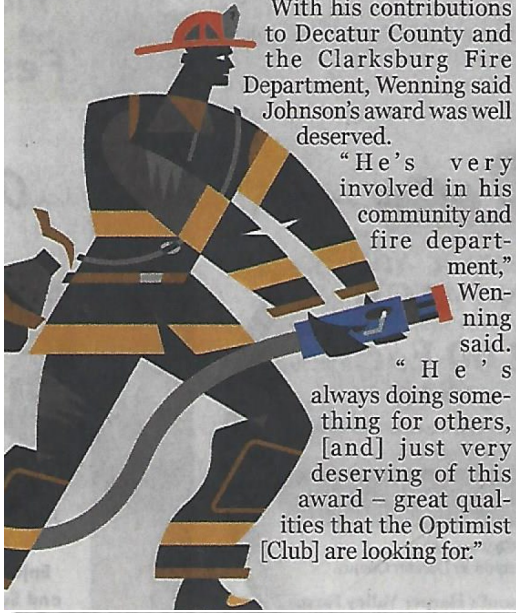
From the Clarksburg Fire Department, Rick Johnson was named this year's award winner.

"It was a total surprise," Johnson said. "I've only been on the department for four years, and this was a surprise."

The man who presented Johnson with the award, Greensburg Fire Department Assistant Chief and 1999 Greensburg Optimist Club Firefighter of the Year award recipient Brian Wenning, said this is the 23rd year the award has been given out.

Wenning also mentioned that typically recipients of the awards have been at their department 20 to 30 years, possibly following in a relative's footsteps.

Johnson took an alternative route. "Rick Johnson is different though," Wenning said. "He retired from UPS after a 30-plus year career from delivery, to semi driving, to management. gency Management Agency.

Johnson took the time to thank the Optimist Club and Decatur County EMA Director Brad Speer for recommending him.

Still, this year's award win-

ner remains humble.

"It's really just exciting that I received the award," Johnson said. "I would have never expected this. It's just an honor when people want to honor you for what you do."



Annual Safety Inspections for Your Chimney

An annual safety inspection should be performed on every fireplace before its first fire of the year. Call a trained chimney professional who knows all the components of a chimney and fireplace to perform a visual inspection.

A visual inspection will look for any deterioration that has happened since last burning a fire. Noticeable cracking of the mortar joints in the firebox, chimney, and flue should be corrected. Any water penetration should be prevented from entering the chimney flue by a good chimney cap. Any fireplace components that are malfunctioning should be repaired or replaced.

The components of a safety inspection that should be inspected include...

Firebox for cracks and fire integrity. For metal fireboxes, the refractory panels that line the firebox should be in good condition. Replace each panel that has a crack splitting the panel into two separate panels.

Damper for proper open and close positions and no rust.

Lintel for proper seal in between firebox and hearth.

Smoke Shelf for no water deterioration, for any nuisance birds and/or critters and their nesting debris.

Flue integrity from any cracks and separation of the flue tiles.

Mortar crowns for cracking to keep out moisture in the chimney chase.

Chimney cap should be present to keep out water damage, birds, and critters. It should protect the mortar crown and the first row of the chimney. Chimney caps also prevent sparks from roof and siding fires.

Chimney from cracks and moisture damage. Water proofing should be applied every 10 years to prevent brick spalling and water penetration.

Chimney Flashing should be sealed and without rust.

Some questions should be asked to the homeowner to ensure a safe fire. What kind of wood do you burn? Seasoned oak is the best performing wood in an inside fireplace. Do you cover your wood outside? Keeping your wood dry limits the amount of smoke created during fire. How often do you do you burn? A chimney sweep is recommended every 1.5 to 2 cords of wood to ensure a smooth exit of smoke and for creosote build up.

A camera inspection should be performed if the chimney cannot be visually inspected in the flue.

Chad Murray with MastersServices in Dallas, Texas says most people call only when there has been a fire that has smoked out their living room. He says almost every smoke problem can be identified before the first fire if an annual inspection is performed. A chimney sweep may be needed after each chimney inspection for safety.

- 1 **PLAN AHEAD** Visit www.IndianaVoters.com or call 1-866-IN-1-VOTE (866-461-8683) to check your voter registration and polling place. You may also call the Indiana Election Division at 1-800-622-4941, your county clerk or county board of voter registration. **Polls are open Election Day from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm, prevailing local time.**
- 2 **BRING PHOTO ID** A voter must provide an Indiana state government-issued or federal government-issued photo ID before casting a ballot. An Indiana Driver's License, Indiana Photo ID card (available free of charge for voting purposes from the BMV), US Passport, Military ID, or Veterans ID is sufficient. The ID must:
 1. Display the **voter's photo**;
 2. Display the **voter's name**, and the name must conform to the voter's registration record (conform does NOT mean identical);
 3. Display an **expiration date** and be current or have expired sometime after the date of the last General Election (except for certain military and Veterans IDs).
- 3 **VOTE EARLY** by taking advantage of your county's **absentee voting** options. Voters who qualify may vote absentee by mail, traveling board, or complete an absentee ballot in-person in the clerk's office or other locations.
- 4 **PAY ATTENTION** Look at the signs at your polling place for directions on how to use the voting machines, a list of your voting rights, information on provisional ballots, and instructions for filing a complaint if your rights have been violated.
- 5 **KNOW THE LAW** Every polling place is required to have facilities and voting machines accessible to elderly voters and voters with disabilities.

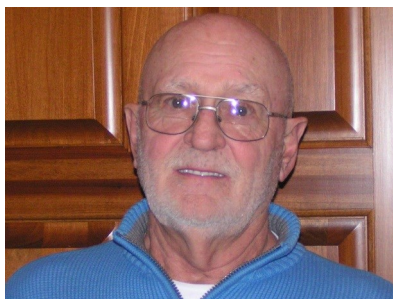

1. Call to Order / Roll Call

President Paul Gosnell called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Members present were Paul Gosnell, Scott Gibbs, Kathy Tarzwell, Jim Hornig, Frank Erdosy, and Larry Kiernan. Also in attendance were Utility Administrator Brittany Green, Utility Superintendent Brandon Litmer, and the District's attorney Anne Poindexter. Absent was Clair Fredrickson.

Guest introduction and short comments (two minutes max)

Guests included Vicki Wilson (510) and Claude Livesay (530).
No comments this month.

2. Consent Items

- a. Minutes of August 16, 2018 Meeting
- b. Financial Report
- c. Register of Claims – Water
- d. Register of Claims – Sewer

A motion was made by Frank and seconded by Kathy to accept the consent items as presented. Motion carried.

3. Superintendent Report

- a. Sewer Status Report
 - i. Brandon reported that everything is operating well and all tests are normal.
- b. Water Status Report
 - i. The water plant is operating on a normal basis with no problems and all tests in the normal range.
 - ii. The quarterly disinfection by-products (DBP) test results were received back from the lab and all results looked very good.
 - iii. Dixon Engineering's warranty inspection report was received and the Contractor will address the items on the list under warranty.
 - iv. A customer asked Brittany about the June and July meter readings. The meters were read on 6/25/18 instead of the normal 15th of the month, which resulted in a longer billing period for June. The meters were read on 7/15/18, as is typical, which resulted in a shorter billing period for July. The net result of the longer billing period combined with the shorter billing period over those 2 months does not affect the overall amount due by a customer.

4. Treasurer Report

- a. Update
 - i. Jayhawk can provide a 2 day / 16 hour over the phone training session for the new customer support specialist for \$1000. It was decided to continue to provide training in house, then decide if additional training is required.

- ii. Jayhawk can add the prorated billing function to our existing software package for an additional cost of \$2500. Brittany recommends not pursuing that as there are only 5-8 account per month that require that calculation and those can be handled without this additional module.
 - iii. Kathy reported that First Financial has finally resolved the issues with getting Michelle set up with on-line banking. The account type has been corrected so there are no surcharges on the accounts. And, the bank has credited the fees it incorrectly charged previously.
- b. Adjustments
- i. A motion was made by Jim and seconded by Kathy to approve the following hidden leak adjustments: Lot 271 for \$285.96; Lot 583 for \$176.27; Lot 775 for \$161.82; and Lot 1270 for \$329.53. Motion carried.

6. Old Business
- a. Property Sale
 - i. Lots 517, 518, and 519 – A second appraisal on Lots 517, 518, and 519 was obtained. The appraiser valued each lot at \$5000. Paul talked to two realtors and obtained pricing from each to sell these lots for the RWWD. After considering each proposal and discussing the possibility of listing the lots ourselves, it was decided to utilize Tree City Properties. 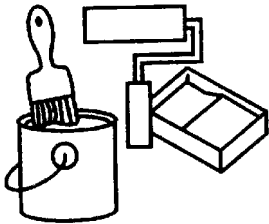

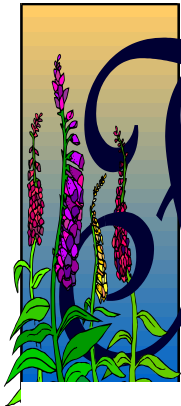

As you sit down to feast upon a wild turkey (*Megalaris gallopavo*), or on a domesticated turkey to celebrate our national holiday of Thanksgiving, here are a few fun facts to spice up the dinner table conversation. Guess which are true and which are false. Answers are at the bottom of the page. PS. There is more than one kind of Wild Turkey to consider. This is about the bird, not the beverage.

- 1) T F Wild turkey is native to North America
- 2) T F The British named it turkey because they associated it with the country Turkey.

White Blue Jays? Yes, you can believe your eyes!

Blue Jays are a popular bird around Lake Santee and usually appear as advertised – blue! Recently in south west Decatur county two white Blue Jays were spotted, a truly rare experience.

Albino blue jays are birds totally lacking in pigment and have pink eyes, skin and feet. Another form of white Blue Jay is one that suffers from a rare genetic disorder that prevents the production of pigment. It is called a leucistic jay and may have some gray among its feathers. Whatever the case, if you see a bird that flies like a Blue Jay, sounds like a Blue Jay and eats like Blue Jay but is white, mark your calendar and call your neighbor. It's probably a once in a lifetime experience!



It's supposed to look like fall by now

Fall is late in coming to Lake Santee this year. As of October 18 hummingbirds are still being sighted in Indiana, including here at Lake Santee. It's worth your time to keep a feeder filled for the stragglers that are late heading south for the winter. Usually by this time fall colors of leaves in the trees are reaching peak season. Not this year, however. A few tinges of red, orange and gold are beginning to lace the edges but we are still seeing green, green and green leaves!

Monarch Watch

In an article by Chip Taylor from September he reports a more promising migration than has been seen for more than a few years. "While the numbers of reported roosts through September is encouraging, and is a signal of a robust migration, the estimated numbers of monarchs are also higher than seen in several years with 17 different roosts estimated to contain 1000 or more monarchs." Interest in tagging also increased this year thus yielding increased information for tracking and studying monarch migrations. Follow Journey North Roost Report 2018 for more information. Abba's Butterfly Garden at the Nature Habitat had a healthy population of caterpillars that decimated the milkweed plants this year. Next year, plant more milkweed!

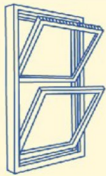

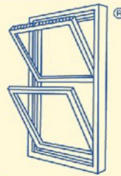

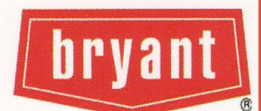

President Lecher called for a review of the minutes of the September 12, 2018 meeting. The minutes were approved on a motion by Carol Goodwin, seconded by Steve Gauck. One correction was made to the minutes for a spelling error where Carol Goodwin's name was misspelled.

Stephanie Peetz gave a brief review of the Treasurer's report. The Treasurer's report was approved subject to audit.

After presentation, the bills were approved for payment on a motion by Carol Goodwin, seconded by Angel Hocker.

MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS AND COMMENTS

Members were asked to introduce themselves and were given the opportunity to express comments.

- A member asked if it would be possible to put up night reflective buoys on the water where existing buoys are located.
- A member asked if the 4th of July boat parade and Memorial Day Golf Cart Parade could be added to the recreation calendar for next year.
 - Shannon stated she would look into it but it was also stated the boat parade has always been put on by individuals not the association.
- A member stated that lake access lot 544 is looking great with the additional fill dirt being added to smooth out the areas from the dredging.
- A member brought up a request to add additional stop signs at road intersections, such as Mohican/Mojave.
 - Brittany stated that maintenance has been working to clear brush at the intersections. Doug also added the board would look into stop signs.
- A member stated there was a black boat playing music excessively loud with at least one song having vulgar language. The board was asked to look at creating a rule to not allow this type of activity or a way to discourage loud music while skiing, tubing, or wakeboarding.
- A member asked that all fishermen be careful when fishing between boats and boat lifts. They have found scratches on their boat that was believed to have been caused by fishing lures.
- Mike Cutrufelli wanted to remind everyone that the CERT meetings are held the 3rd Wednesday of the month at the EOC office. Please contact Mike if you would be interested in joining CERT.

CORRESPONDENCE

Brittany presented the board with two pieces of correspondence. One was an email from a member in regards to multiple concerns with the possibility of allowing RV/Camper storage on lots. The letter stated that this would negatively impact the property values at Lake Santee. The second letter was in regards to loud music being played on boats as individuals are wakeboarding, skiing, and tubing.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Rules & Regulations – Carol Goodwin

Carol stated that she has put together a small committee to start looking at the existing rules and regulations to see if any of them need updated.

Carol then presented a rule change and the second reading of Rule 2.9 (f).

2.9 – *Motorized Carts*

f.) Motorized carts operated after dark will be inspected annually and must be with the following functional safety devices: two (2) white headlights, one (1) on each front corner, two (2) red taillights one (1) on each rear corners, reflectors on each side, turn signals, brake lights, white or amber cautionary light visible 360 degrees. Front, rear, and cautionary lights must be visible under normal conditions for a minimum of 500 feet.

Carol asked for a motion with Steve Gauck providing a second. When asked if there were any comments, Polly Fox stated when recently looking at golf carts she found that the newer models no longer have two lights but rather lights all the way across the front of the cart. Carol stated with this additional information she would like to withdraw her motion on the second reading to allow further research. The purpose of updating the rule was because of the limited availability of amber rotating lights and the POA wanting to stay up to date on current availability in the golf cart market.

Carol completed the second reading of a new rule to section 7 (Fishing) of the existing rules. She then proceeded with the second reading of rule 7.13.

7.13 – *Fishing*

Introduction of outside species is strictly prohibited unless authorized in writing by Board of Directors. Violators will be subject to fines and loss of Lake Santee privileges.

Carol asked for a motion to accept rule 7.13 as read with Steve Gauck providing a second, motion carried. Carol Goodwin then asked for a motion to waive the third reading and move forward with the rule addition. Polly Ann Fox provided a second, motion carried.

Recreation – Shannon Gibbs

Shannon stated that the last golf cart run of the season would be Saturday, October 13th. Trick or Treat & Trunk or Treat would be held on October 27th starting at 5PM. She announced that the Holiday Lighting Contest would take place on December 8th and Breakfast with Santa would be December 15th.

Lakes & Beaches – Randy Ostendorf

Randy stated that the fish survey was completed on Monday (10/8) and he hoped to have the results by the November board meeting. He thanked Craig Duncan for allowing him to go out on the water to view the fish count. He stated the lowering of the lake would start the following week. It will be lowered 5-6ft to allow for repairs to docks and also hoped for a gizzard shad kill off again this year. Randy said he has been contacted by some members who would like to see the boat ramp extended out further to allow for putting boats in during the winter months without the worry of scratching the boats or props. – he will look into this.

A walking/running path has been mowed under the power lines that goes from Pueblo Trail to Chippewa Trail. As a reminder to please clean up after your pets while walking.

She stated that we were four properties on tax sale and we were able to pick two properties up that did not have anyone bidding on them. Lot 1512 for \$156.51 and lot 1086 for \$337.54. The prior owner would have one year to redeem the property. Doug added that due to the timing of the tax sale the board held an executive session between regularly scheduled meetings and voted to allow the purchase of lots in the subdivision.
