FIFTY YEARS OF KEEPING LAKE SANTEE ASSOCIATION MEMBERS INFORMED

The First Edition

The Booster Club decided that the date of the first edition of the *Smoke Signals* would be March 28, 1969, and it would be in the mail by that date. The first edition was sent out to 1,183 members. Of those, 859 were mailed within Indiana, 284 were mailed to Ohio and 40 were reported as being mailed to various parts of the WORLD. One *Smoke Signals* was mailed to Puerto Rico, while 39 of the remaining 40 were mailed within the United States.

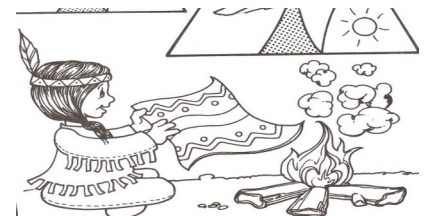
The inaugural edition was seven pages long. It did not have a cover page, but it did contain five advertisements. The *Smoke Signals* would be published every month until 1971 when it would be published only 11 months out of the year, January through November. Beginning in December 1995, the *Smoke Signals* resumed publication in December.

Rosella Adams served as the Editor of the *Smoke Signals* until May 1971. Many have followed in her footsteps but, like many others in those early years, Rosella blazed a trail where none existed for Lake Santee.

In June 1969 Decatur County REMC helped the Booster Club print the *Smoke Signals* and introduced a cover. While the REMC was only able to help with the printing for a few months, the cover stayed. In fact, the *Smoke Signals* would use the same cover until 1996.

The minutes of the Board of Directors meetings were summarized in the GREAT GREY PUFFS section until 1970. Shortly after Charlie Hutton took office, the official minutes of the Board meetings were published in the *Smoke Signals*.

By the second anniversary of its introduction, publications of the *Smoke Signals* were averaging eight pages per issue. Postage costs were rising - the cost of a postage stamp in May 1971 had just risen from six cents to eight cents. The cost to send the publication each year was reported to be \$1,000 for the 1,151 copies being mailed out each month.

While the *Smoke Signals* has changed and grown from those original seven pages to a 100 page full-color publication, what has not changed is that there are still about 1,100 *Smoke Signals* printed each month and that the Booster Club is still completely self-funded and published by volunteers. Since its inception, the *Smoke Signals* has been funded by donations from the members who receive the newsletter and from advertisements. The members of the Booster Club have been responsible for raising the funds to print the *Smoke Signals*, as well as, for writing the content, printing and assembly of the newsletter.

There have been times in the lake's history when the fate of the *Smoke Signals* was questionable. In 1973, for example, a plea for volunteers went unanswered for several months and it appeared that the newsletter may come to an end. Fortunately, volunteers stepped in to keep the *Smoke Signals* running.

The paper was printed on a mimeograph machine for many, many years. In 1975 the Booster Club purchased an electric mimeograph machine, which was a great timesaver! In August of 1995, the *Smoke Signals* was printed on brand new equipment that was purchased after several months of fundraising within the community. After 10 cover styles and several different types of machines, the *Smoke Signals* have been professionally printed by Moeller Printing Company since September 2010.

Booster Club

During the February 16, 1969, Board of Directors meeting, the Booster Club committee was formed. The committee was comprised of Charles Hutton, Max Barnett, Virgil Hite, Rosella Adams, Betty Holestein, Florence Reynolds and Carolyn Shelby.

On February 17, 1969, the first meeting of the Booster Club was held. The need for and advantages of a Booster Club were discussed, agreed upon and the club was formed. Lou Zimmerman was elected the first Chairman; Virgil Hite was elected Vice Chairman; Carolyn Shelby was elected Secretary-Treasurer; and Rosella Adams the Editor of the Santee *Smoke Signals*. The Booster Club became the first club organized at Lake Santee and, after **50 years** the Booster Club is still serving the Lake Santee community.

The LSPOA allotted \$200 to finance the Booster Club and the club voted to have yearly membership dues of \$1.00 per family to raise additional funds. Members who paid their yearly membership received a card and were added to the "Totem Pole" listing in the *Smoke Signals*.

Today, the primary focus of the Booster Club is the production and distribution of the *Smoke Signals* and an annual property owners directory.

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Frozen Fog on the trees Nancy Fredrickson February 2, 2019

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Approximately 250 people in the United States died last year from the "Silent Killer" -- carbon monoxide (CO). This deadly gas is hard to detect because it is odorless, colorless and tasteless. UL recommends that consumers follow these steps to help prevent carbon monoxide poisoning:

- * Have a qualified technician inspect fuel-burning appliances at least once each year. Fuel-burning appliances such as furnaces, hot water heaters and stoves require yearly maintenance. Over time, components can become damaged or deteriorate. A qualified technician can identify and repair problems with your fuel-burning appliances.
- * Be alert to the danger signs that signal a CO problem: streaks of carbon or soot around the service door of your fuel-burning appliances; the absence of a draft in your chimney; excessive rusting on flue pipes or appliance jackets; moisture collecting on the windows and walls of furnace rooms; fallen soot from the fireplace; small amounts of water leaking from the base of the chimney, vent or flue pipe; damaged or discolored bricks at the top of your chimney and rust on the portion of the vent pipe visible from outside your home.
- * Be aware that CO poisoning may be the cause of flu-like symptoms such as headaches, tightness of chest, dizziness, fatigue, confusion and breathing difficulties. Because CO poisoning often causes a victim's blood pressure to rise, the victim's skin may take on a pink or red cast.
- * Install a UL Listed CO detector outside sleeping areas. A UL Listed CO detector will sound an alarm before dangerous levels of CO accumulate. CO indicator cards and other devices are also intended to detect elevated levels of CO, but most are not equipped with an audible alarm, and cannot wake you at night, when most CO poisonings occur.
- * Read the manufacturer's instructions carefully before installing a CO detector. Do not place the detector within five feet of household chemicals. If your detector is wired directly into your home's electrical system, you should test it monthly. If your unit operates off of a battery, test the detector weekly and replace the battery at least once a year.
- * Avoid placing your detector directly on top of or directly across from fuel-burning appliances. These appliances will emit some CO when initially turned-on. Never use charcoal grills inside a home, tent, camper or unventilated garage. Don't leave vehicles running in an enclosed garage, even to "warm up" your car on a cold morning.
- * Know how to respond to a CO detector alarm. If your alarm sounds, immediately open windows and doors for ventilation. If anyone in the home is experiencing symptoms of CO poisoning -- headache, dizziness or other flu-like symptoms -- immediately evacuate the house and call the fire department. If no one is experiencing these symptoms, continue to ventilate, turn off fuel-burning appliances and call a qualified technician to inspect your heating system and appliances as soon as possible. Because you have provided ventilation, the CO buildup may have dissipated by the time help responds and your problem may appear to be temporarily solved. Do not operate any fuel-burning appliances until you have clearly identified the source of the problem. A CO detector alarm indicates elevated levels of CO in the home. Never ignore the alarm.

The Clarksburg Community Volunteer Fire Department urges you to recognize the danger signs of CO before any harm can come to you or your family.

The six holidays are: Memorial Day weekend, Flag Day, July 4th weekend, Labor Day weekend, September 11th, and Veteran's Day. The flags are posted a dawn and taken down at sunset by volunteers at the Lake. Each of the flags has been flown over the nation's Capital. The Optimist Club is responsible for replacement of any flag soiled, damaged or stolen.

Brandon stated it is time to replace the 9,900 pounds of carbon, he provided a quote of \$12,771.00. A motion was made by Jim and seconded by Claude to order and replace the carbon for \$12,771.00. Motion carried. The carbon will be replaced approximately 2/1/2019.

Brandon stated that on 12/26/2018 an IDEM inspector did an inspection concerning a report of a spill with a valve being left open and a tripped circuit breaker. Brandon had filed the required spill report and did the walkthrough with the inspector and all was found to be compliant.

b. Water Status Report

Brandon reported that the plant is operating well and all tests are normal.

The IDEM inspector also did inspections for 3 anonymous complaints.

1. A concern we are not flushing hydrants once a year, we currently flush all hydrants every year in April. The inspector suggested we flush twice a year, so Brandon will flush in April and October in the future.
2. A red stain on a shower curtain, all results found to be in normal ranges.
3. High chlorine levels, Brandon tested several areas and all areas tested in normal levels.

Over all the inspections went well and all areas of the plant were shown to be compliant, It is difficult to address concerns without lot numbers. If you have any concerns please call Brittany or Brandon and we will check them out.

7. Administrator Report

The annual Audubon Christmas Bird Count that originates at Michaela Farm in Oldenburg includes Lake Santee in the 15 mile radius that also covers Batesville, Metamora, Indian Lakes, Salt Creek and St. Mary’s. Seven teams of 2-5 birders identified 2,841birds in 53 species, a “low average” according to Wayne Wauligman, compiler for the count. One highlight was a record number of 16 bald eagles.
